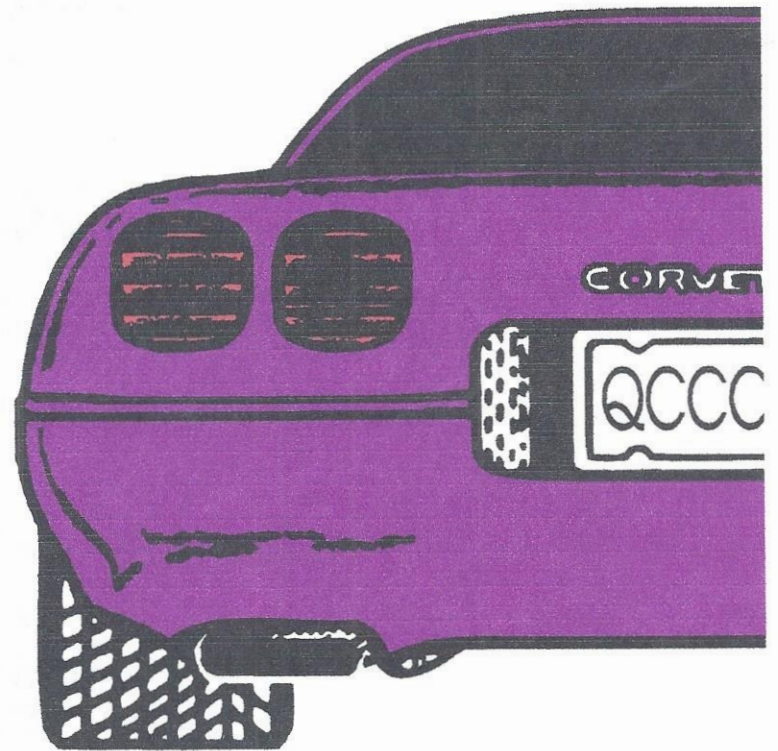

Our August business meeting, and pool party will be held at the home of Carlette & Ron Calloway.

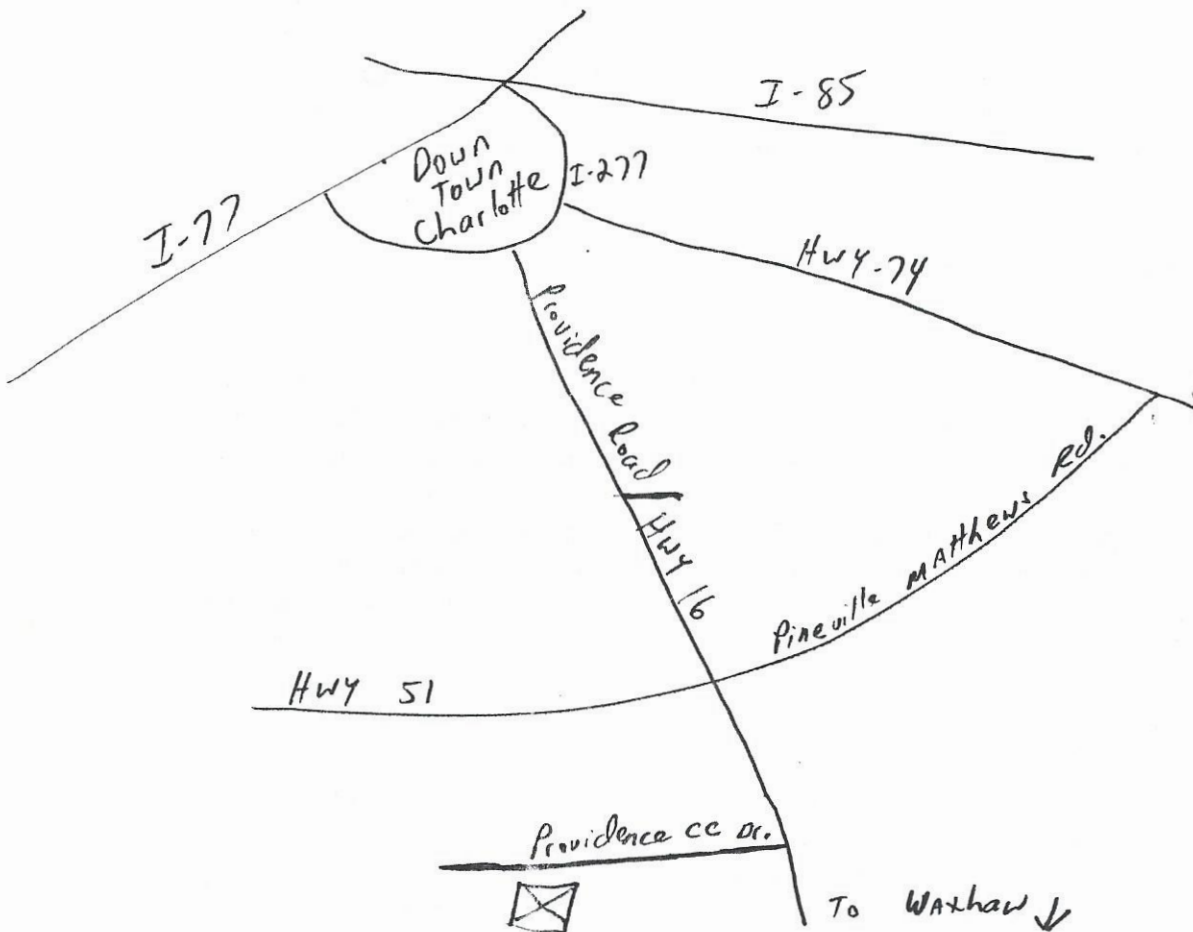

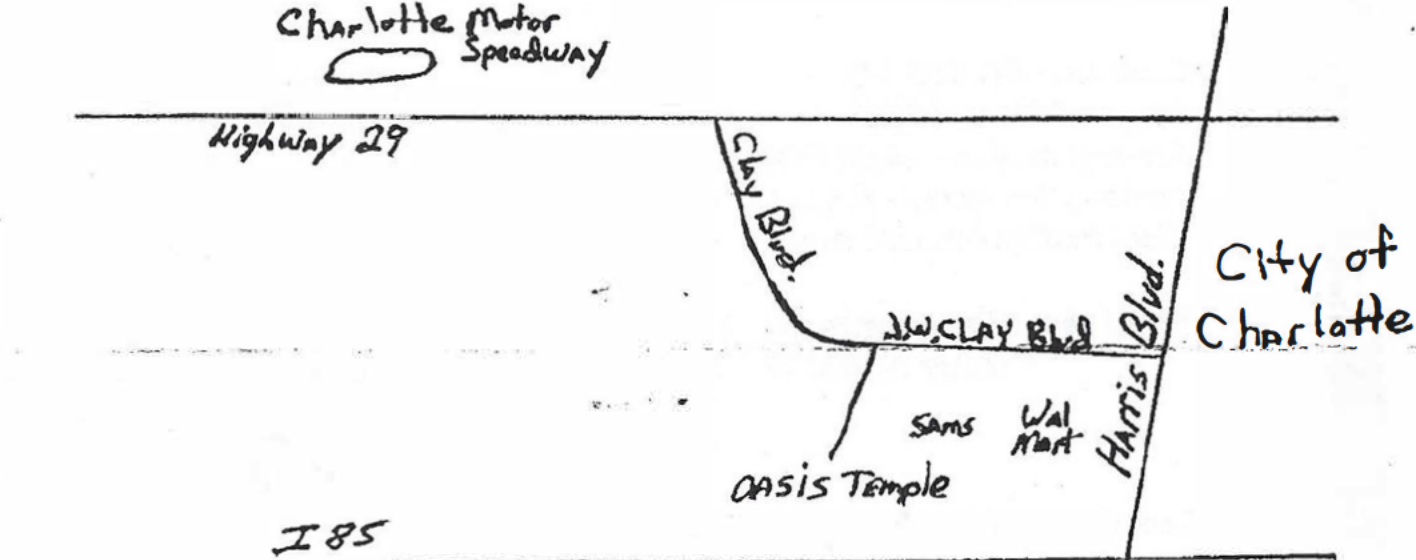


MAP TO CAR SHOW AT OASIS SHRINE TEMPLE

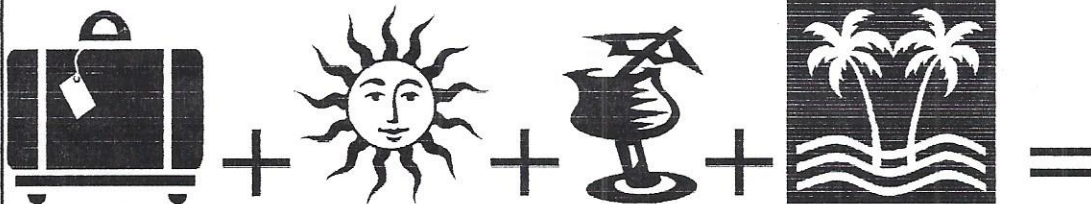
