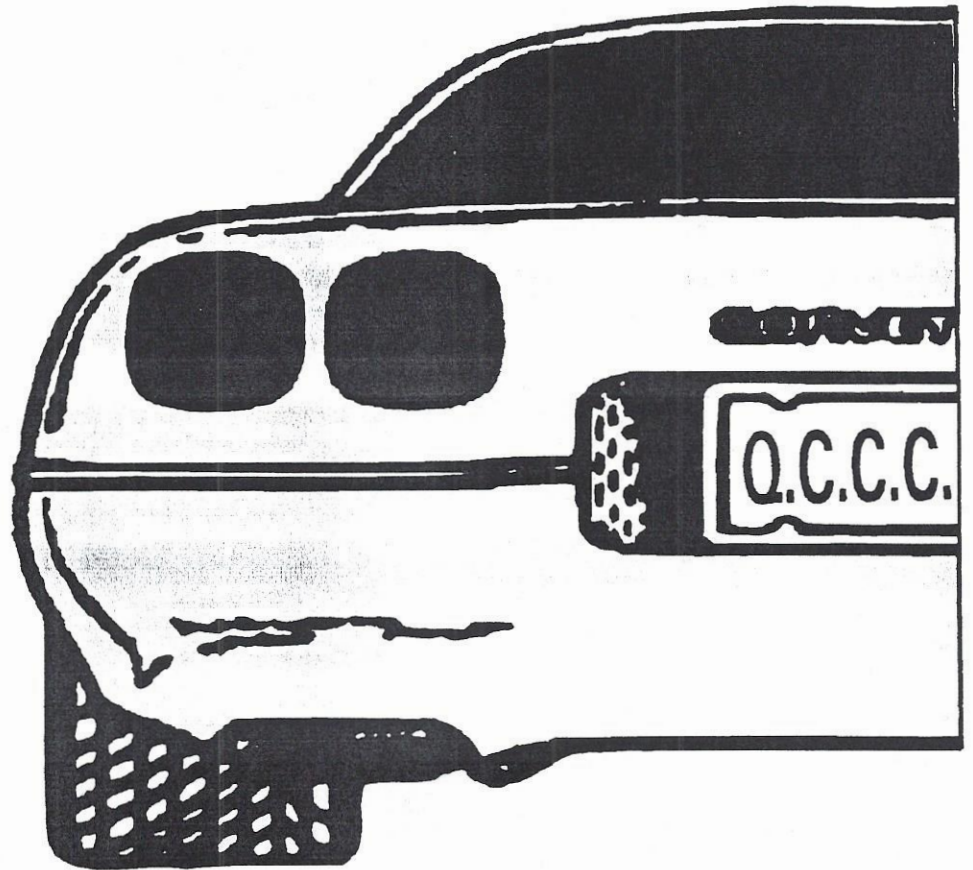

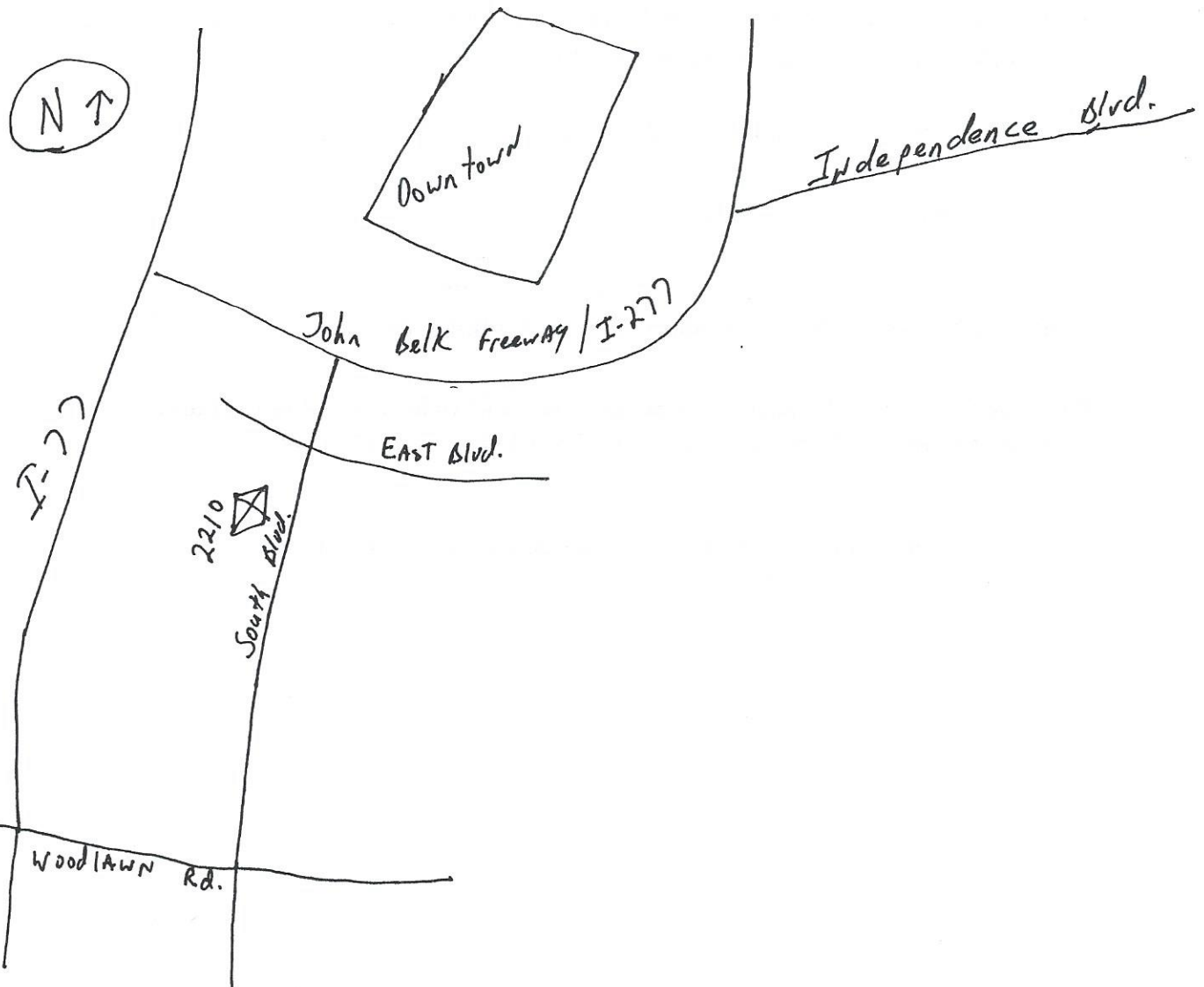

The call committee will be in touch with you soon to confirm your attendance and share this months menu items to bring.

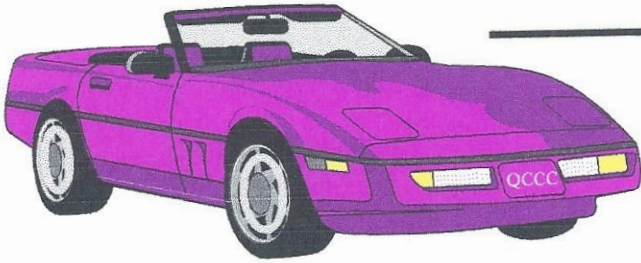

A motion was made that we adjourn the meeting.

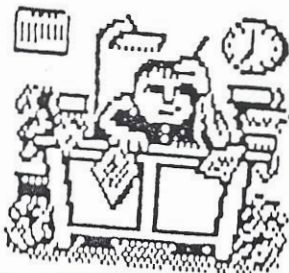
