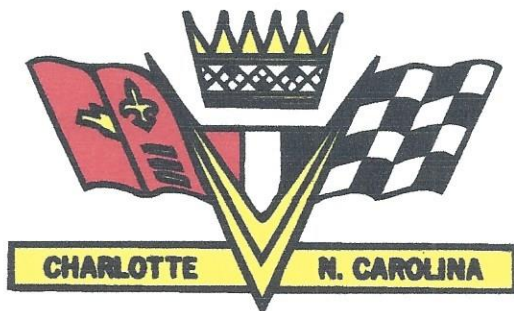

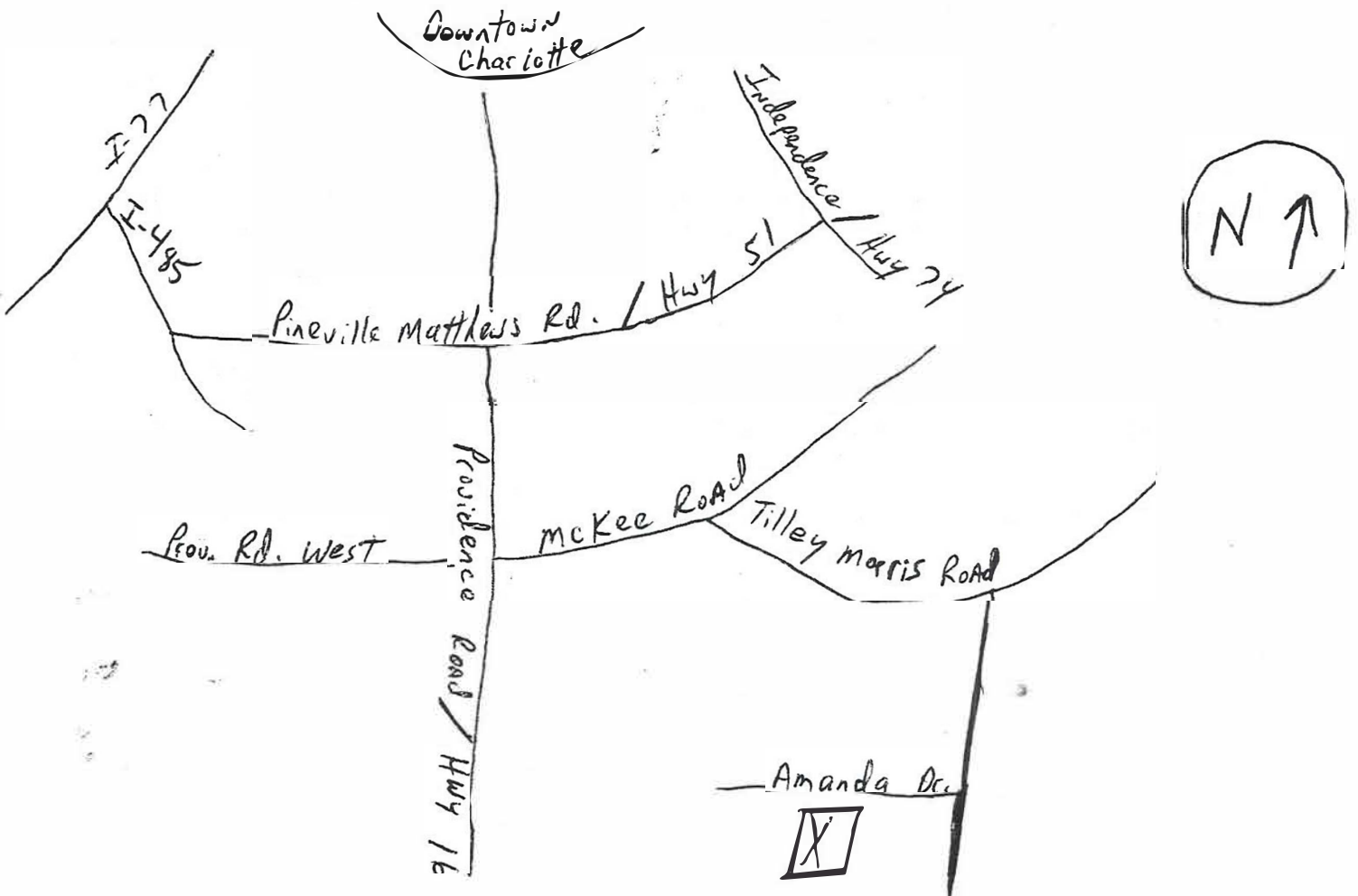

We will need to advertise the Sectional in Blue Bars, the deadline is December 1st.

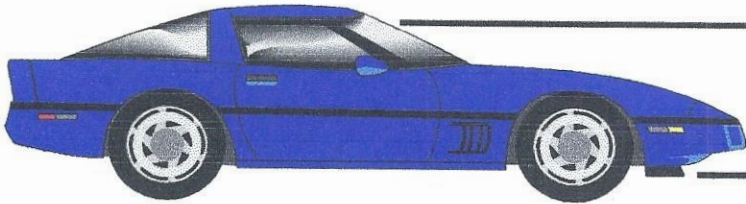
