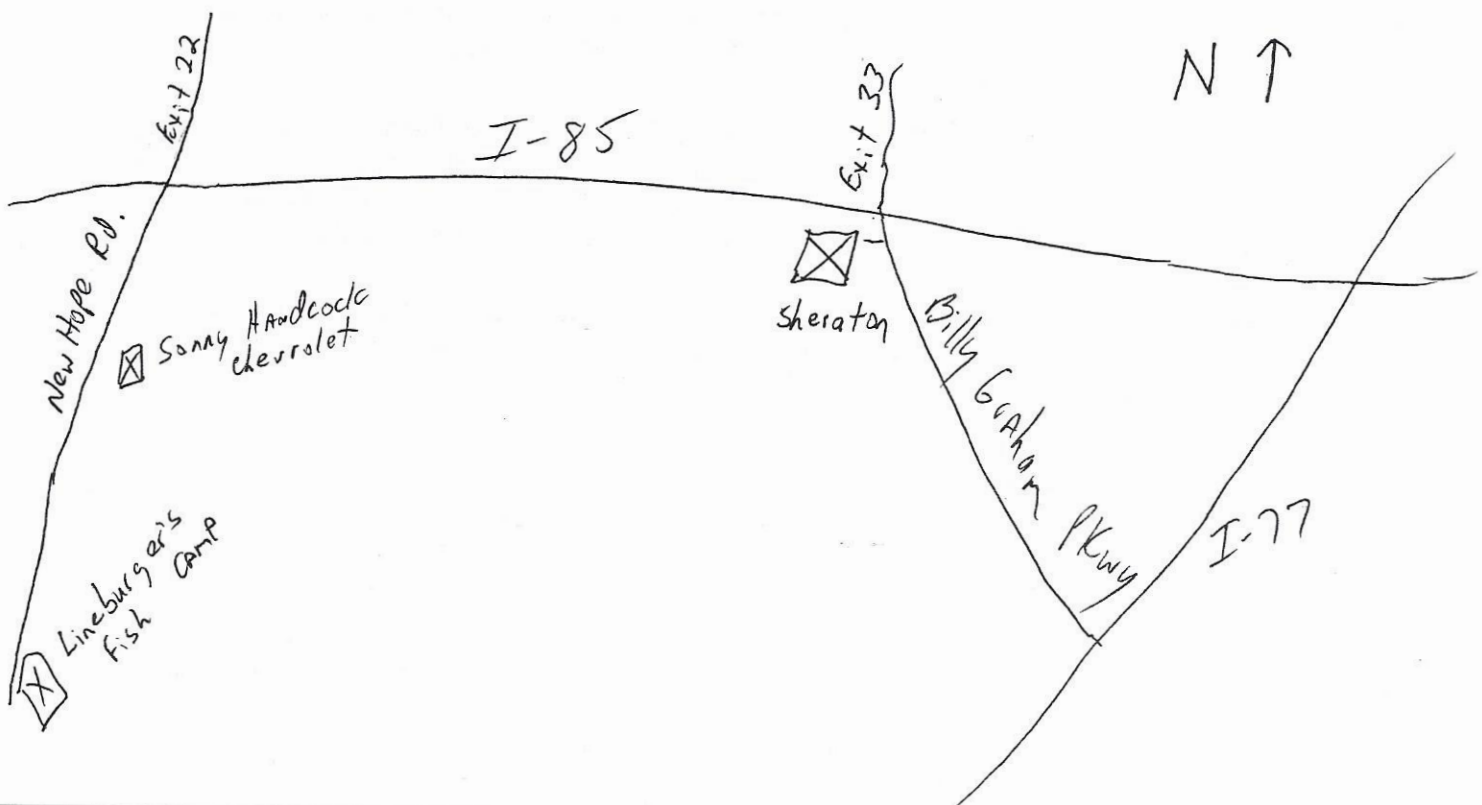
Our October business meeting will be held a week earlier than usual. Also, please note the earlier starting time of 5:00 pm.

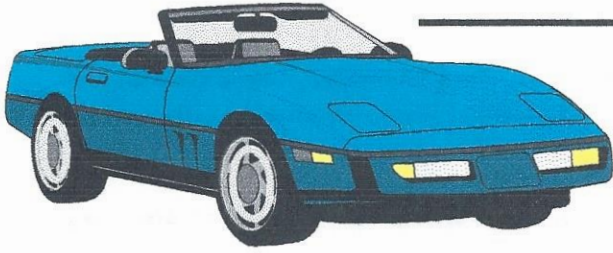
VP of Social

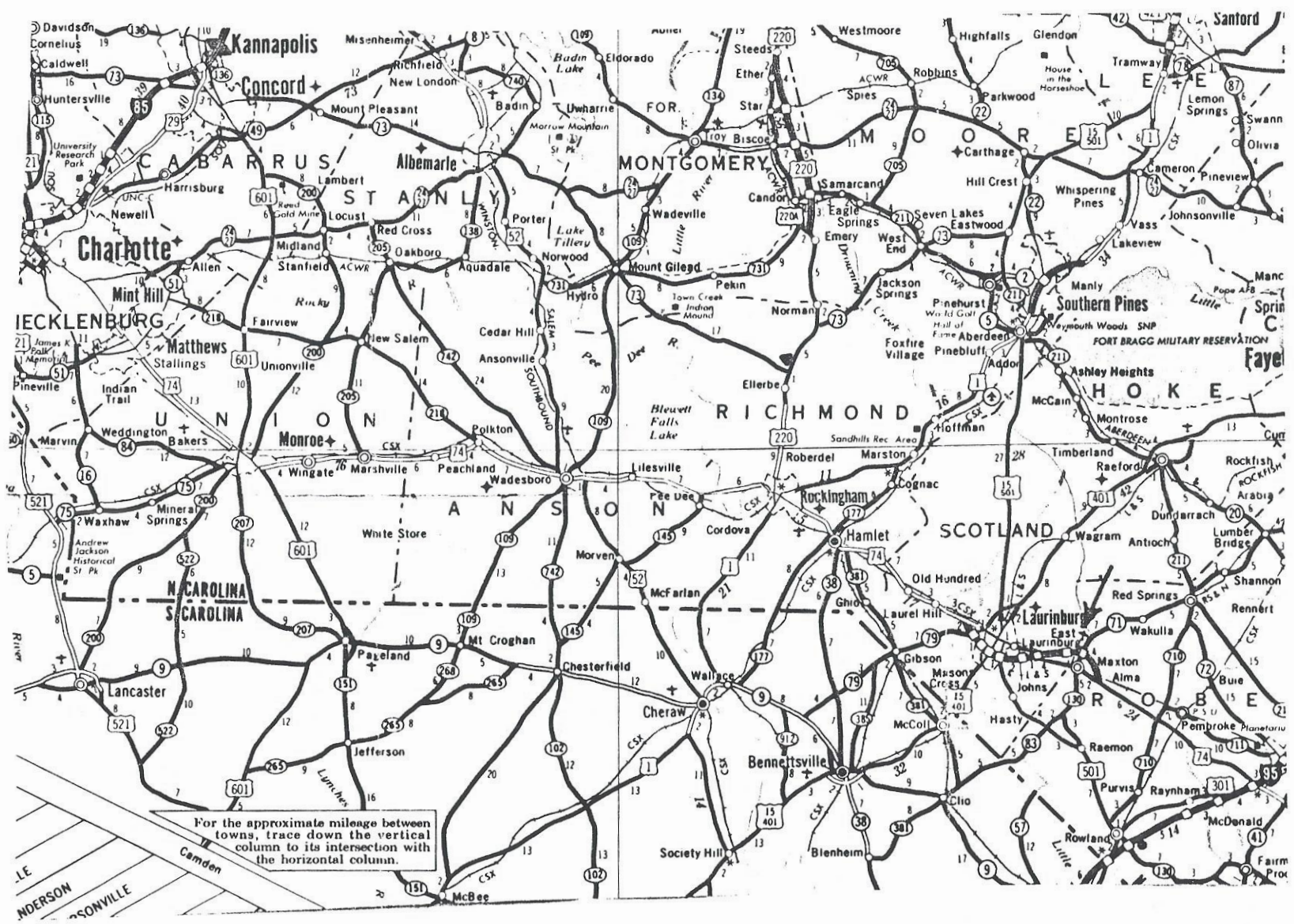
