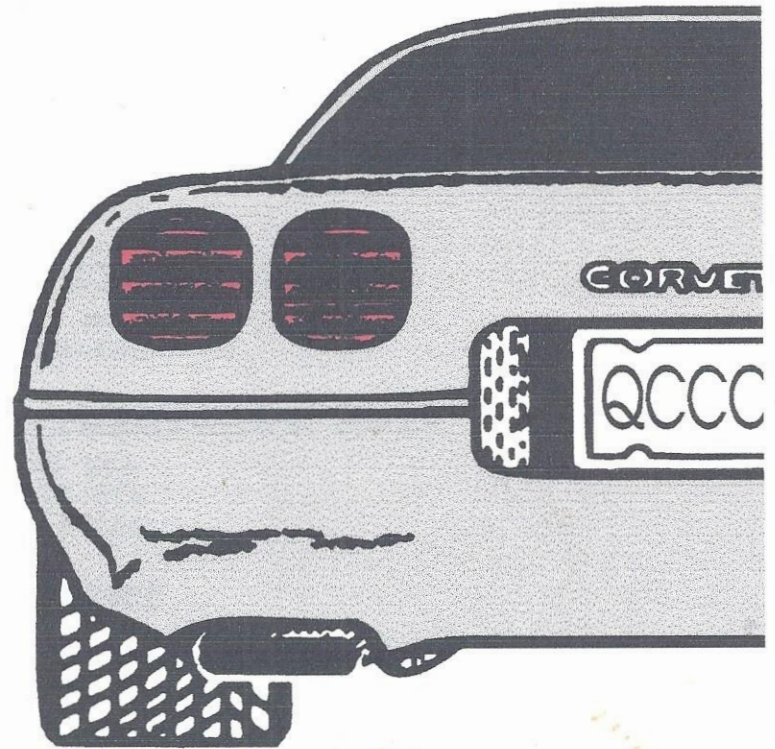

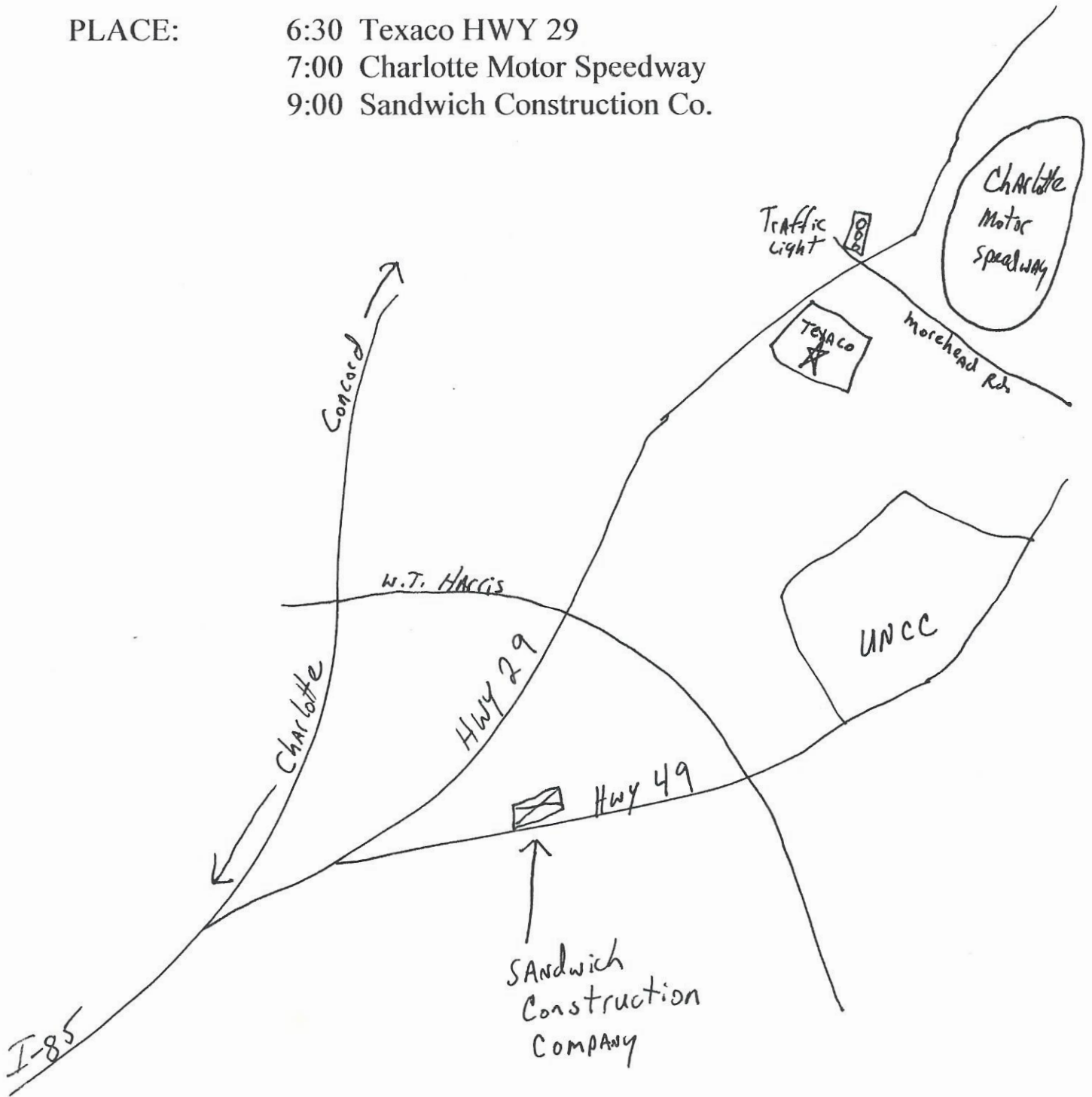

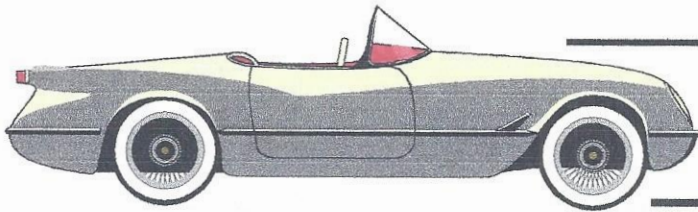
May 4 Habitat for Humanity Car & Truck Show, Belmont, NC

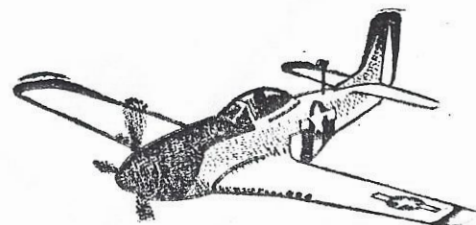
Habitat for Humanity 3rd Annual Car & Truck Show
