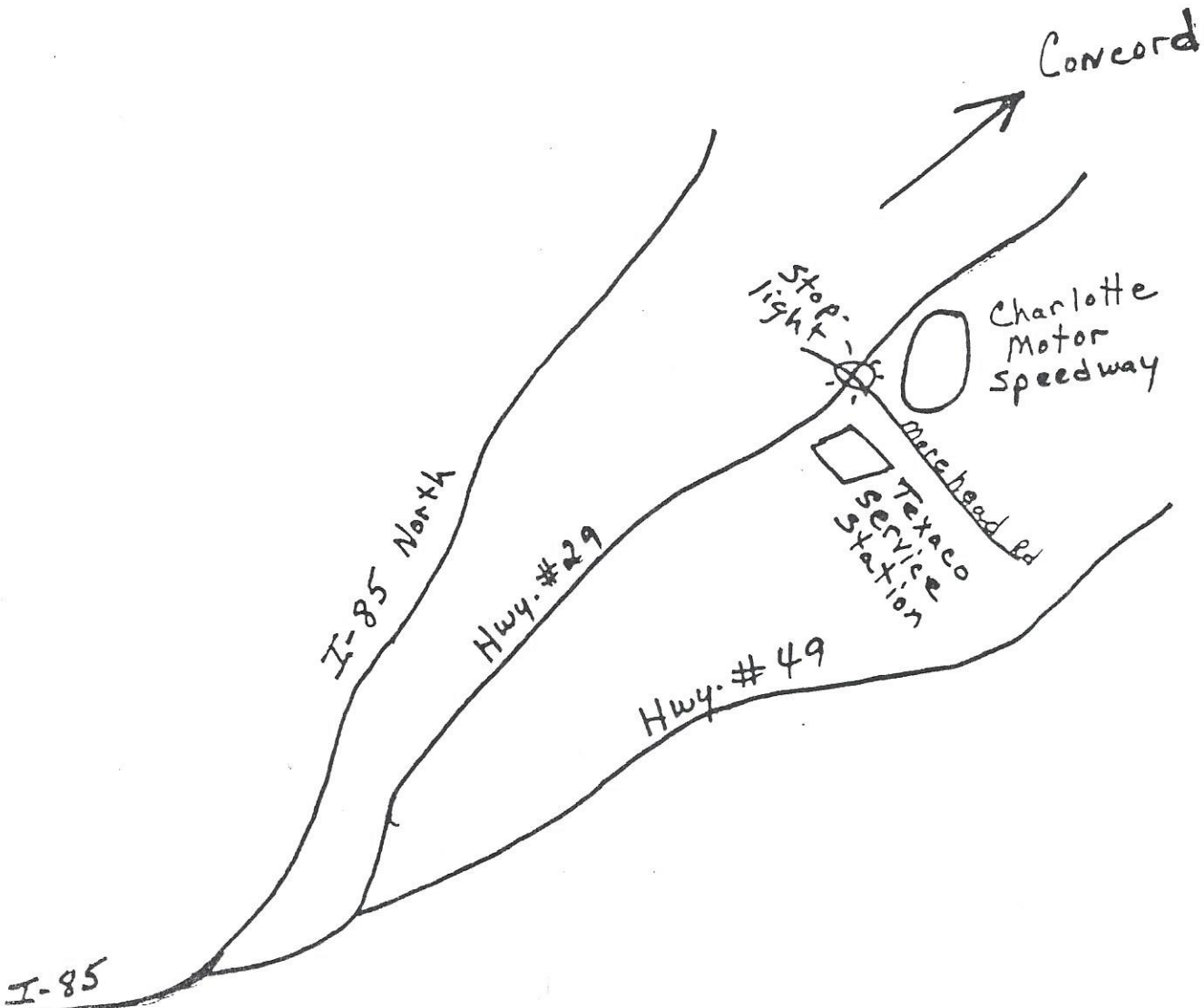

The deadline for applying for a NCCC Scholarship is May 1st. If you need an application see Jay.

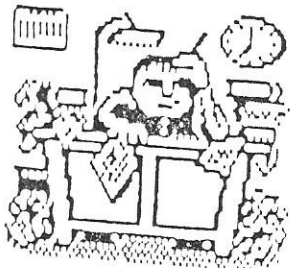
OLD BUSINESS: Chris Andrews is going to check on the price of a welder.

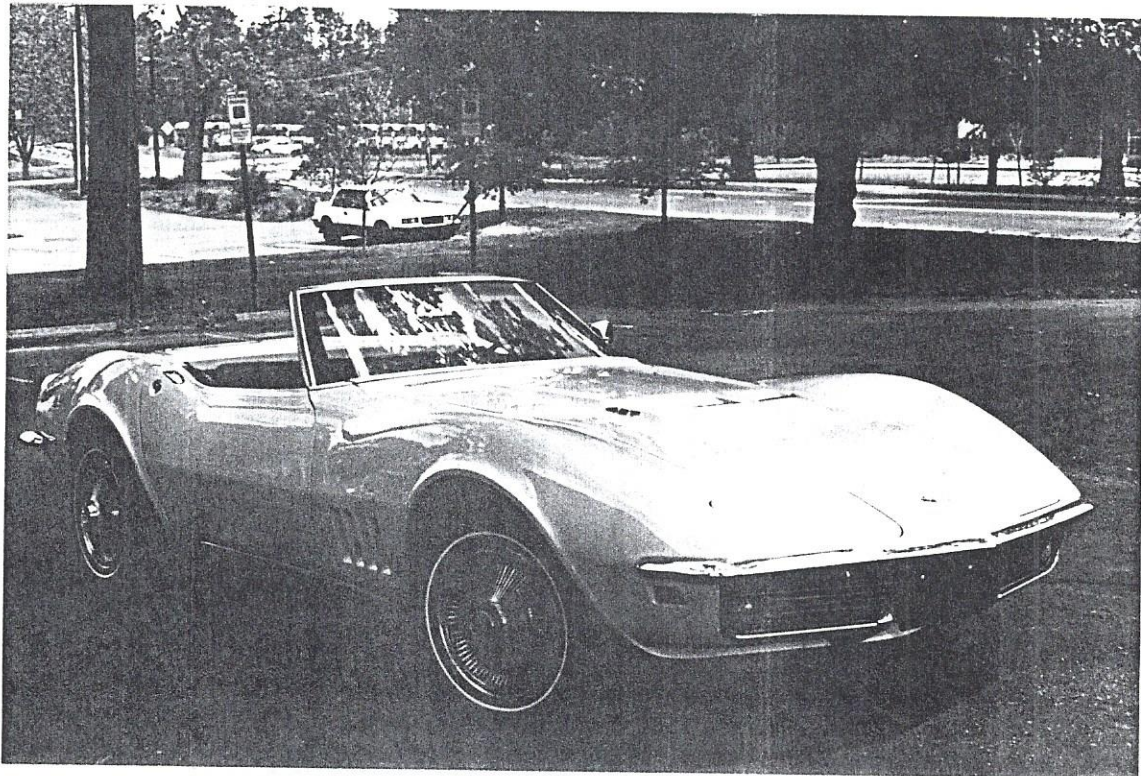


Vice President of Social

Don't forget the Beach Trip September 8-10. Mark your Calendars!

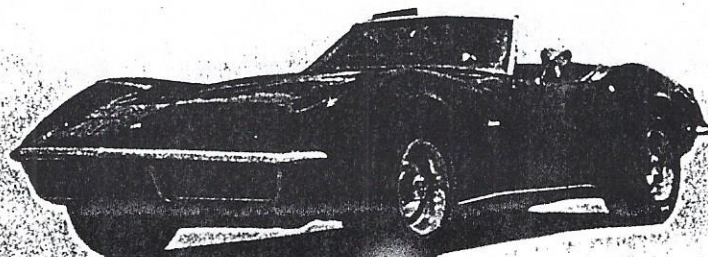
