

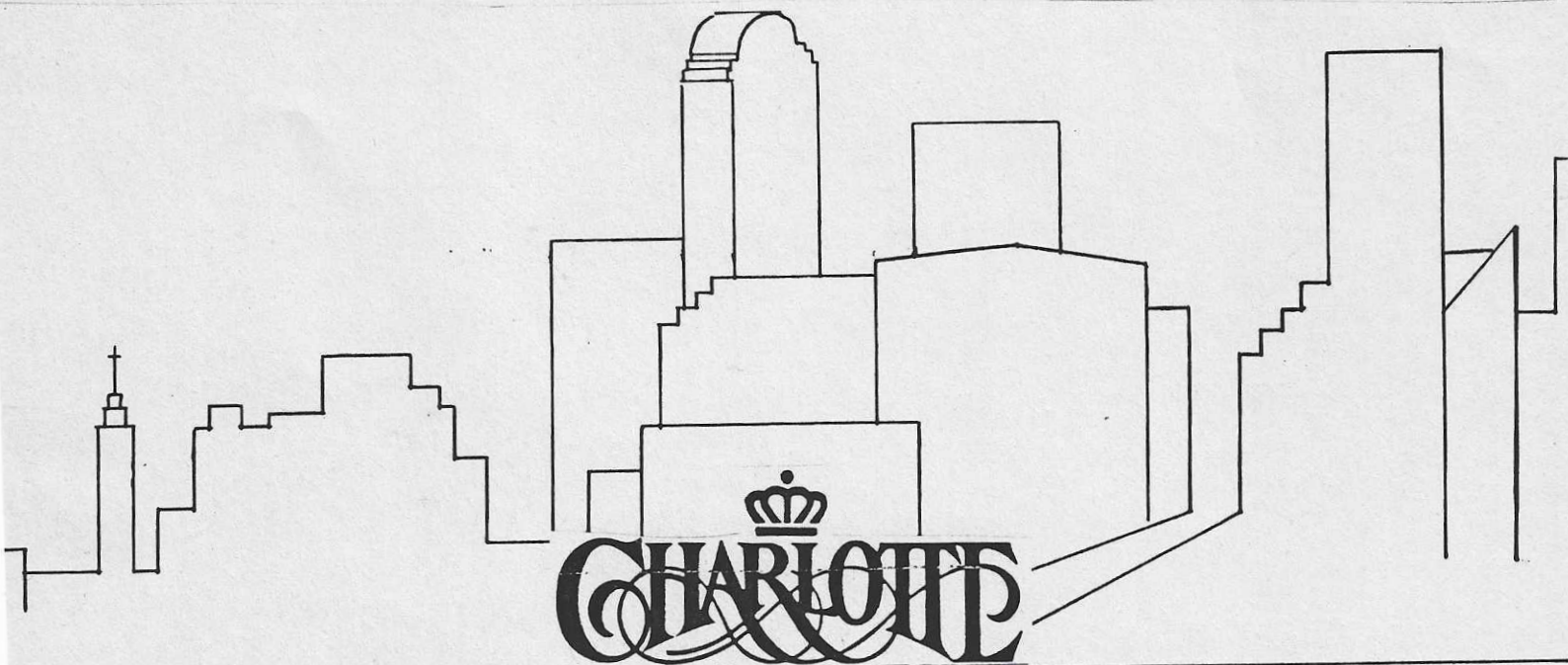

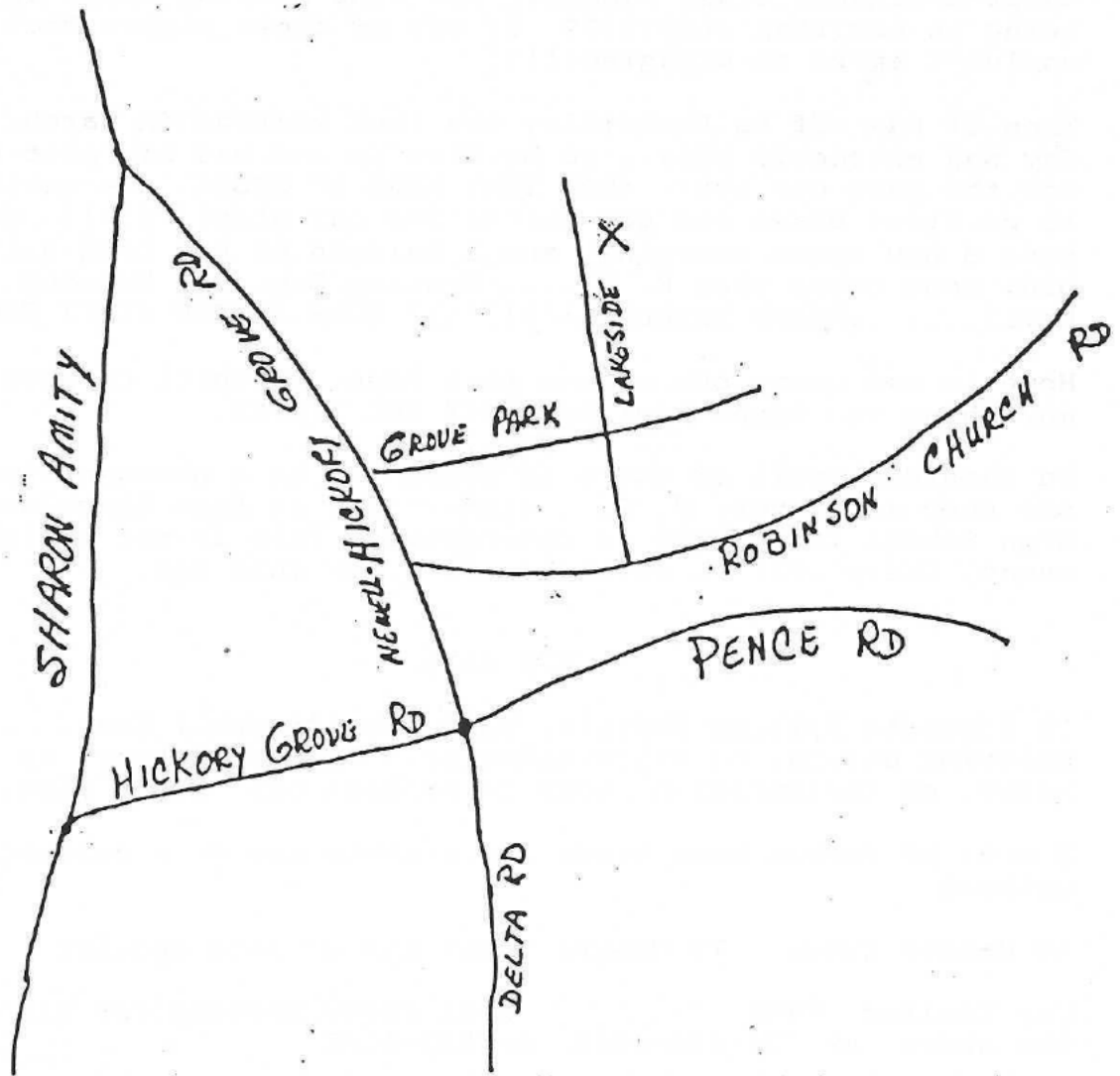

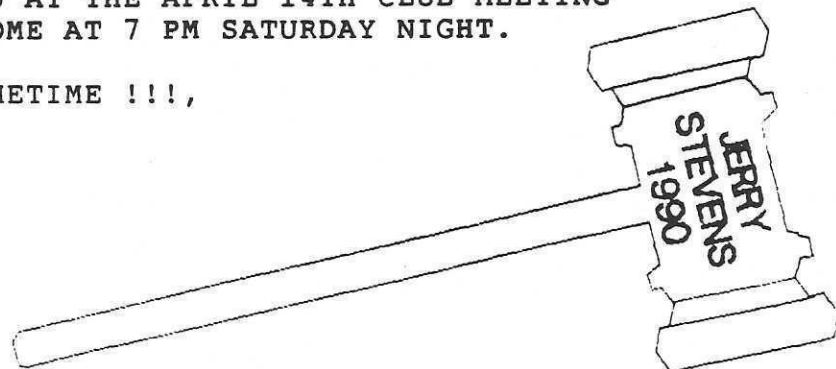

A motion was made not to pursue a sponsor for the Convention T-Shirt. After much discussion, the motion was tabled.

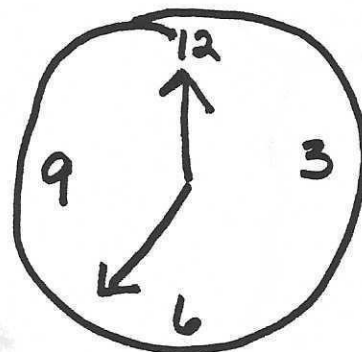
Jerry Stevens announced that Melvin Pace had turned in his resignation, and that he would be greatly missed. We hope to see Melvin often in the future.
