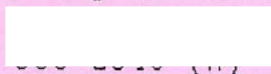

Our condolences to Linda Abernathy and her family on the lost of her Grandmother.

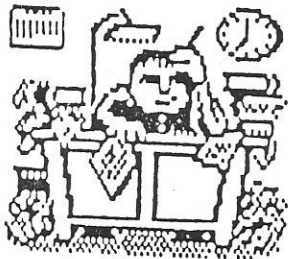
A motion was made that we adjourn the meeting.

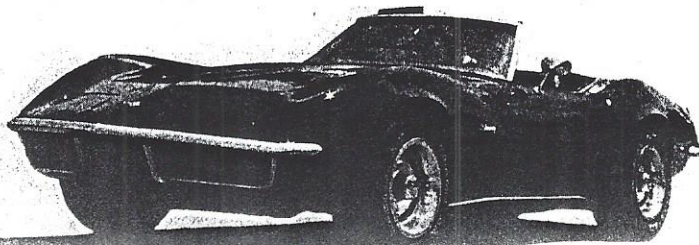

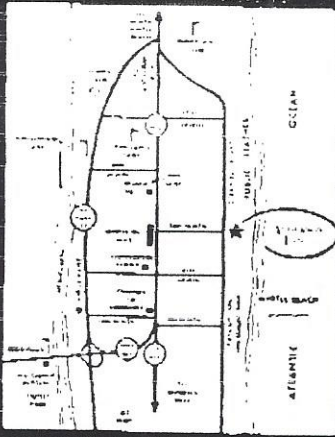
Vice President of Social

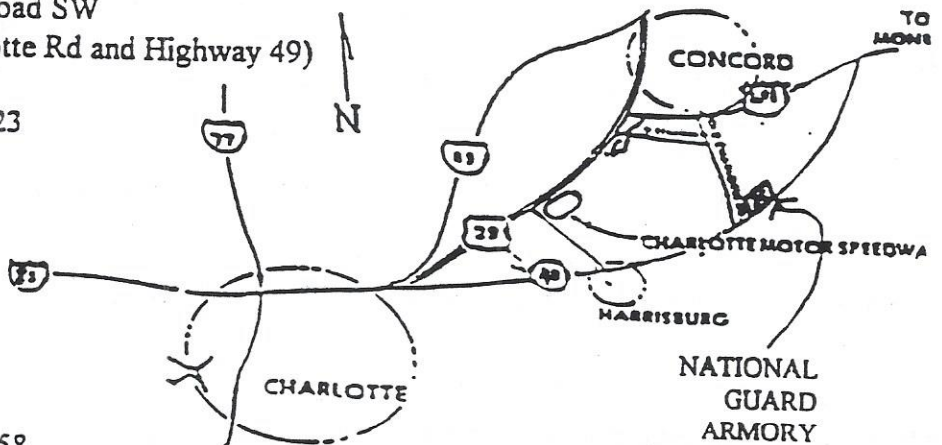
