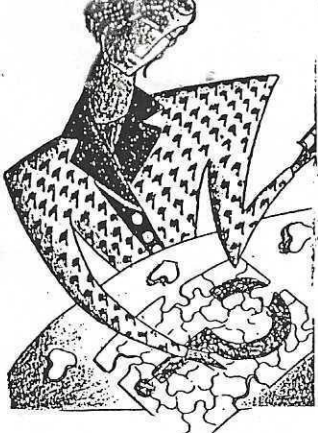
Keep up the good work and participation and increase both if you can.
