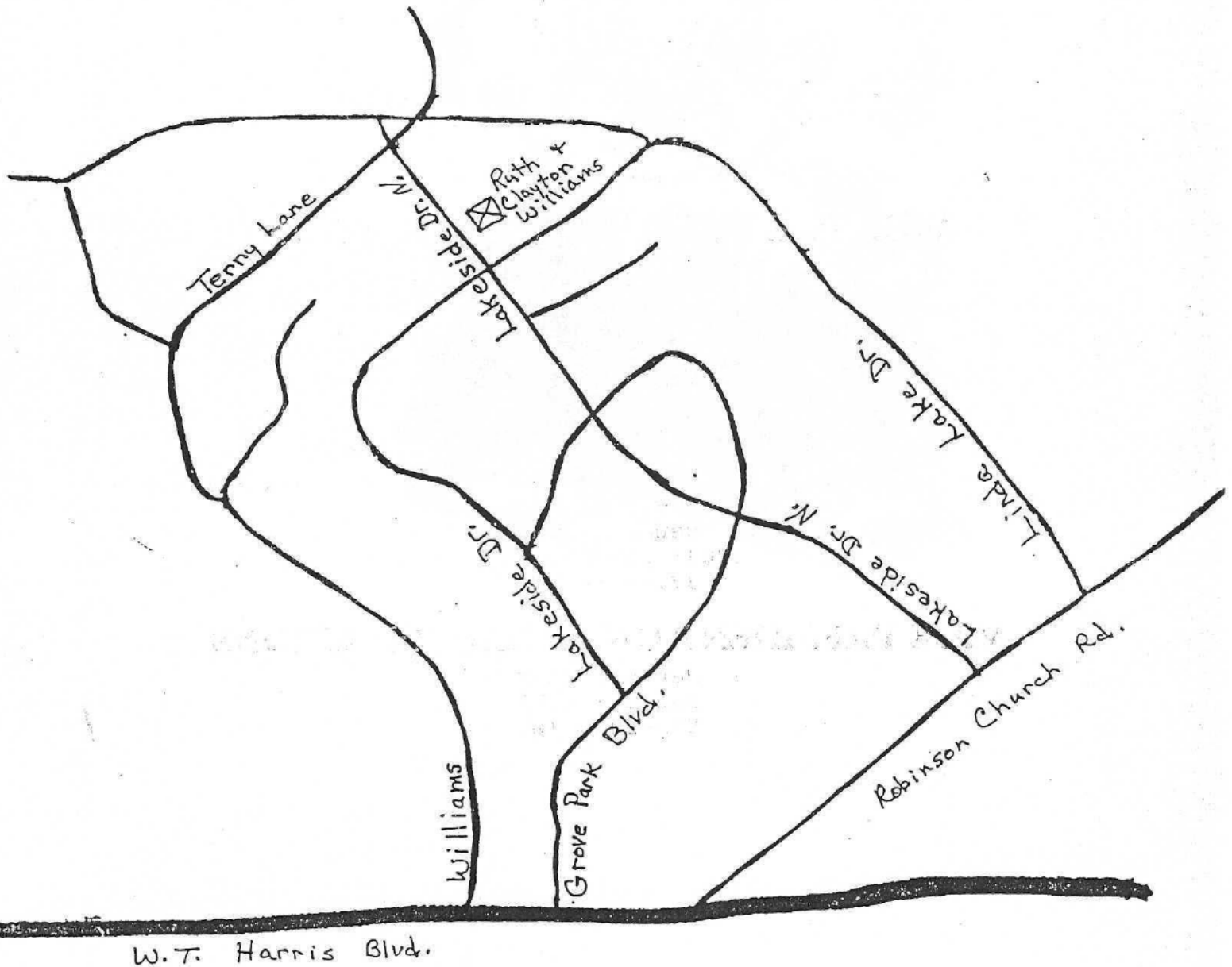

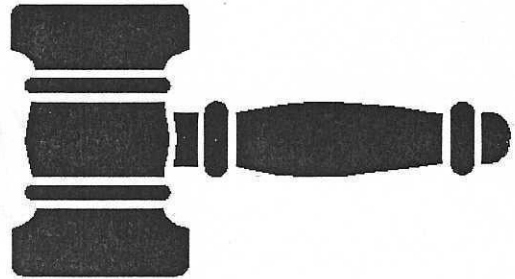

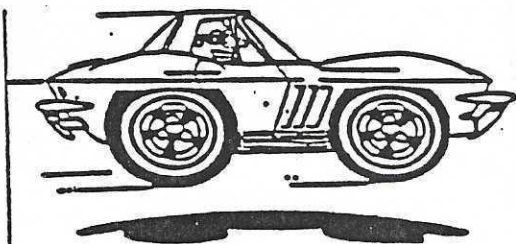
Speaking of speed events, remember if you plan to participate as a driver, helmets must be updated and fire extinguishers must be charged and mounted.
