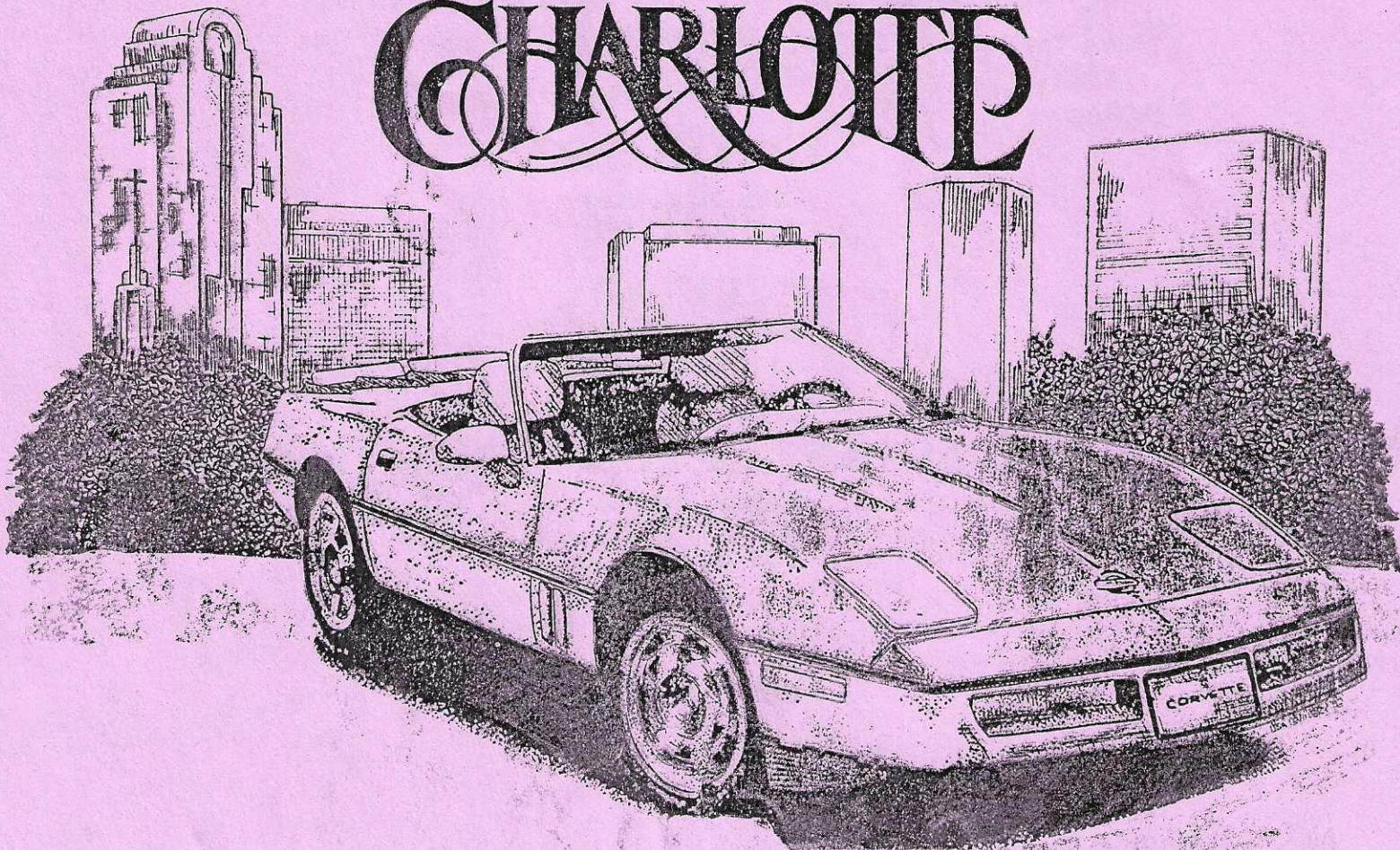

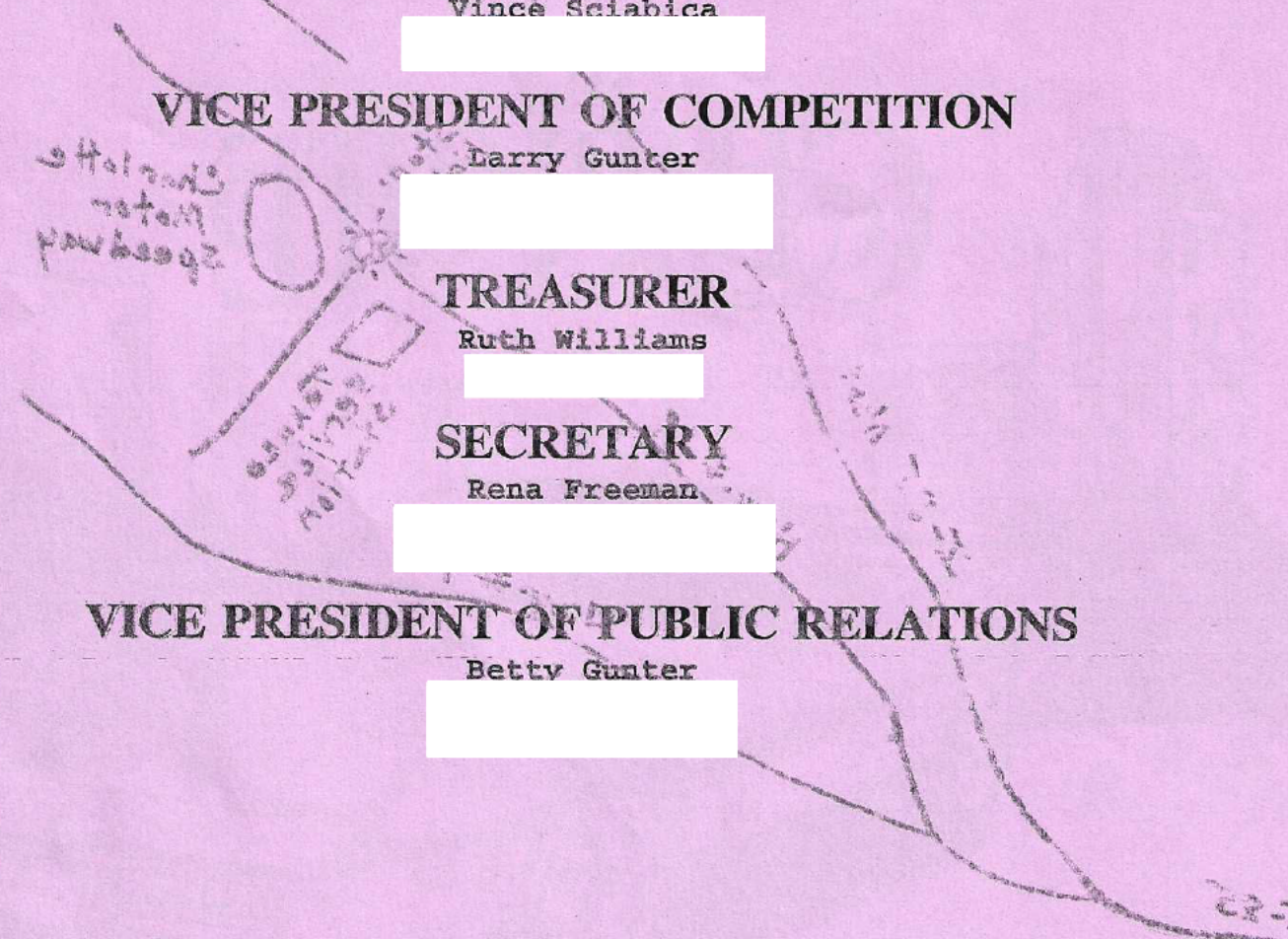

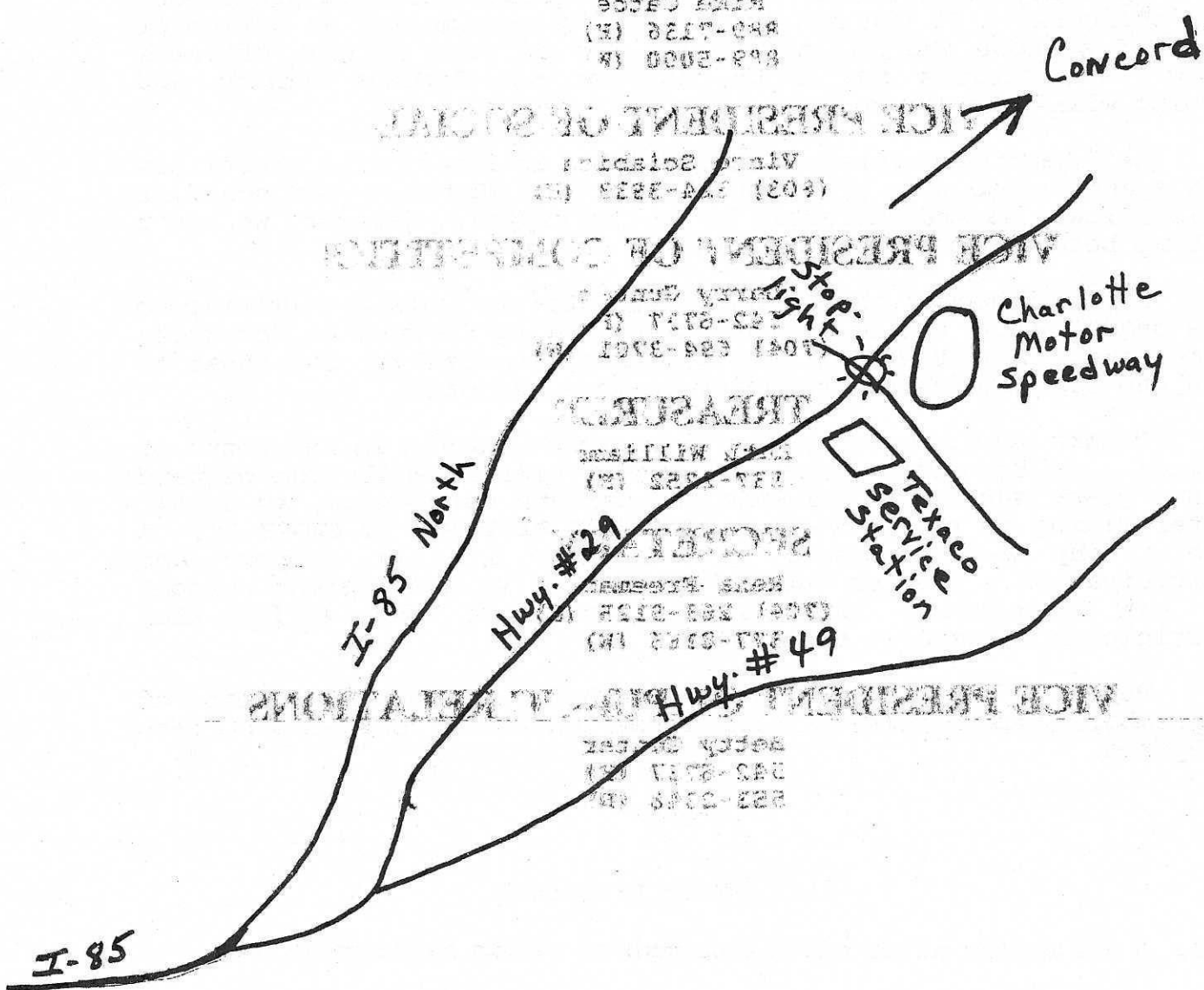




# QUEEN CITY CORVETTE CLUB SEPTEMBER BUSINESS MEETING
