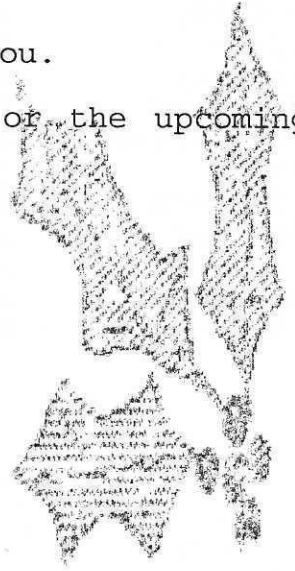
Don't forget, we have a few events left this year - - - so come join in the fun and comradery (see newsletter for details).

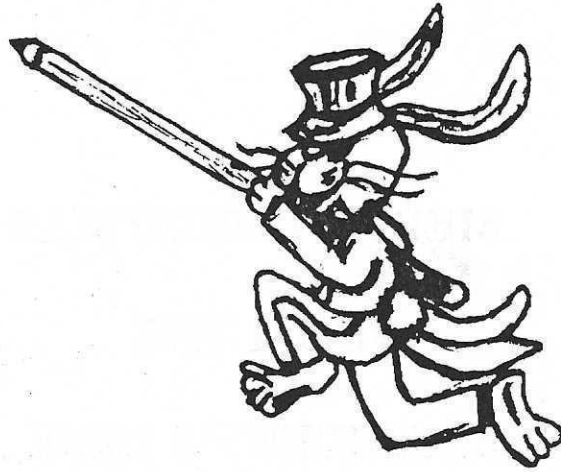

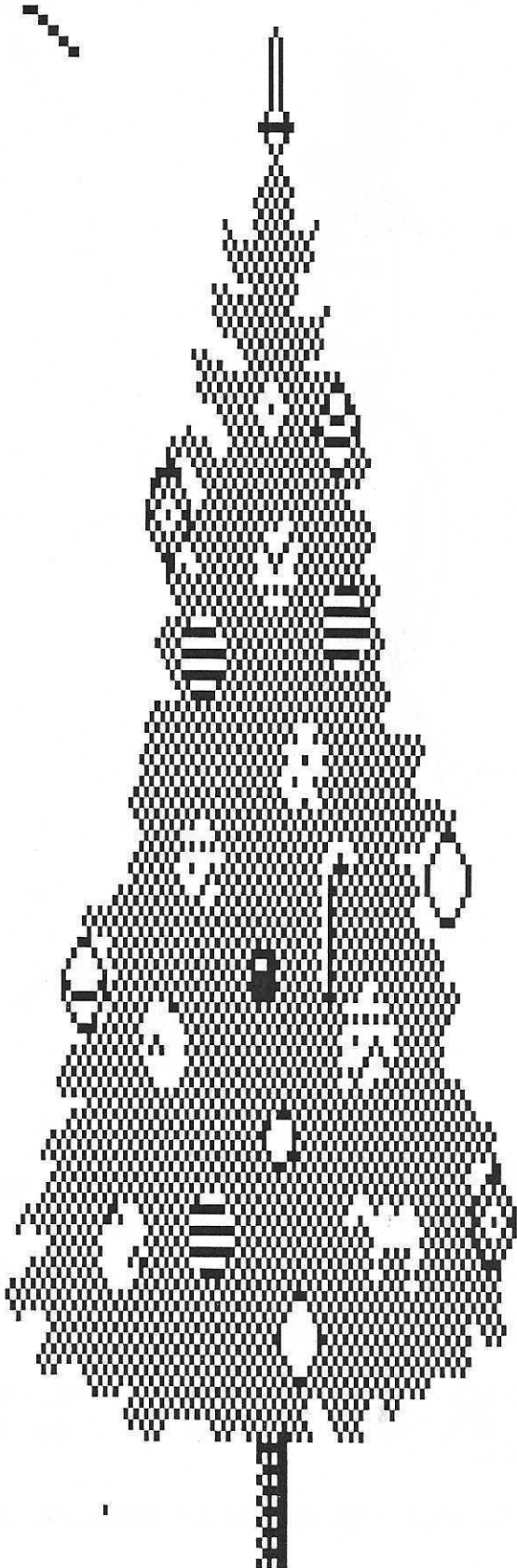

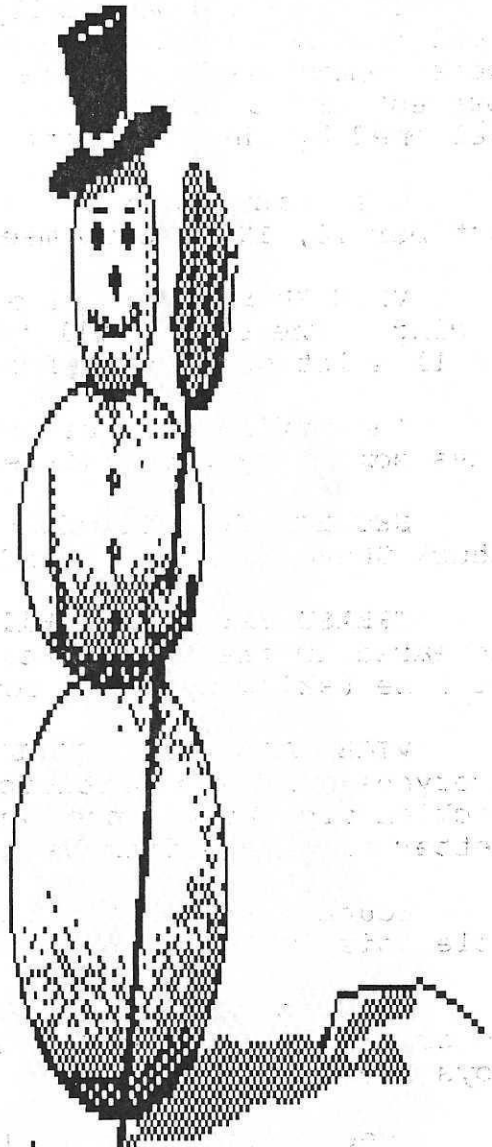
My understanding is the Awards Banquet is scheduled for January 16th, so keep the date open on your calendar. More detailed information to follow shortly.

# WOOOOW CHECK-UP

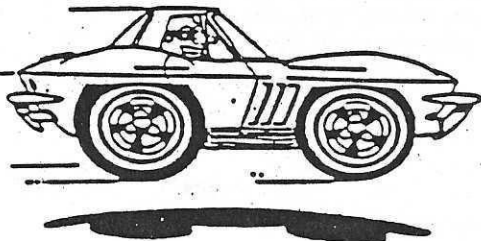
