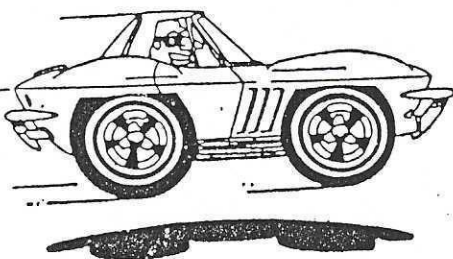
There have also been times of sadness as we lose friends and loved ones, especially former QCCC member Randy Lanier. However, they all expect us to go forward and remember the good times.
