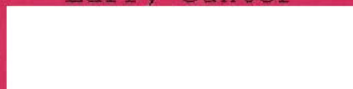

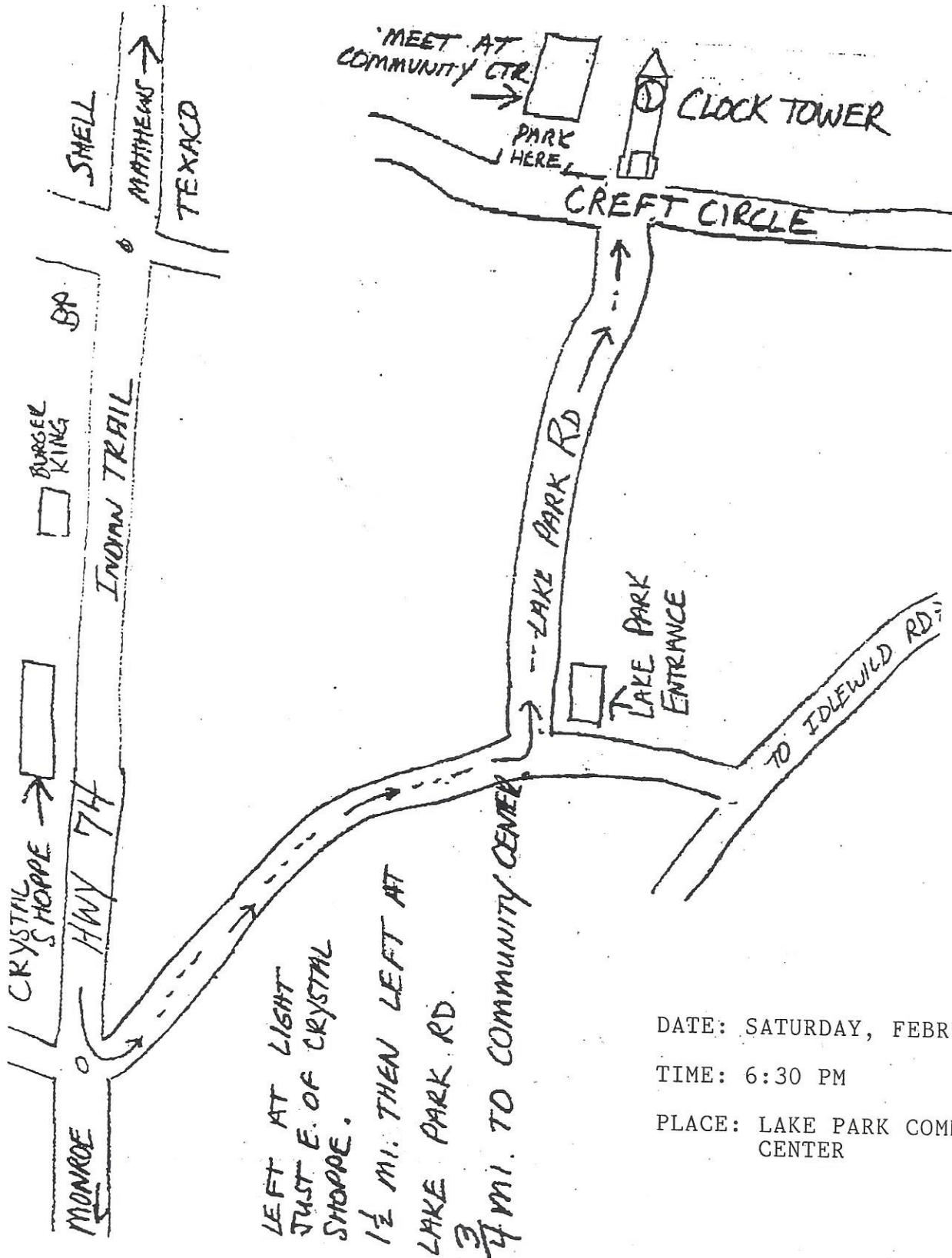

FROM THE PRESIDENT


First of all I would like to thank everyone who attended the banquet. I hope everyone had a good time. Congratulations to all the award winners.

The club seal is missing. If it is not located Jay will have it replaced.

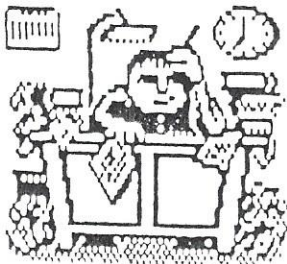
Jim says the AutoFair is April 6-9, more details to follow later.

Mark your calendars for 1995. We have planned some fun events this year and hope you will participate.

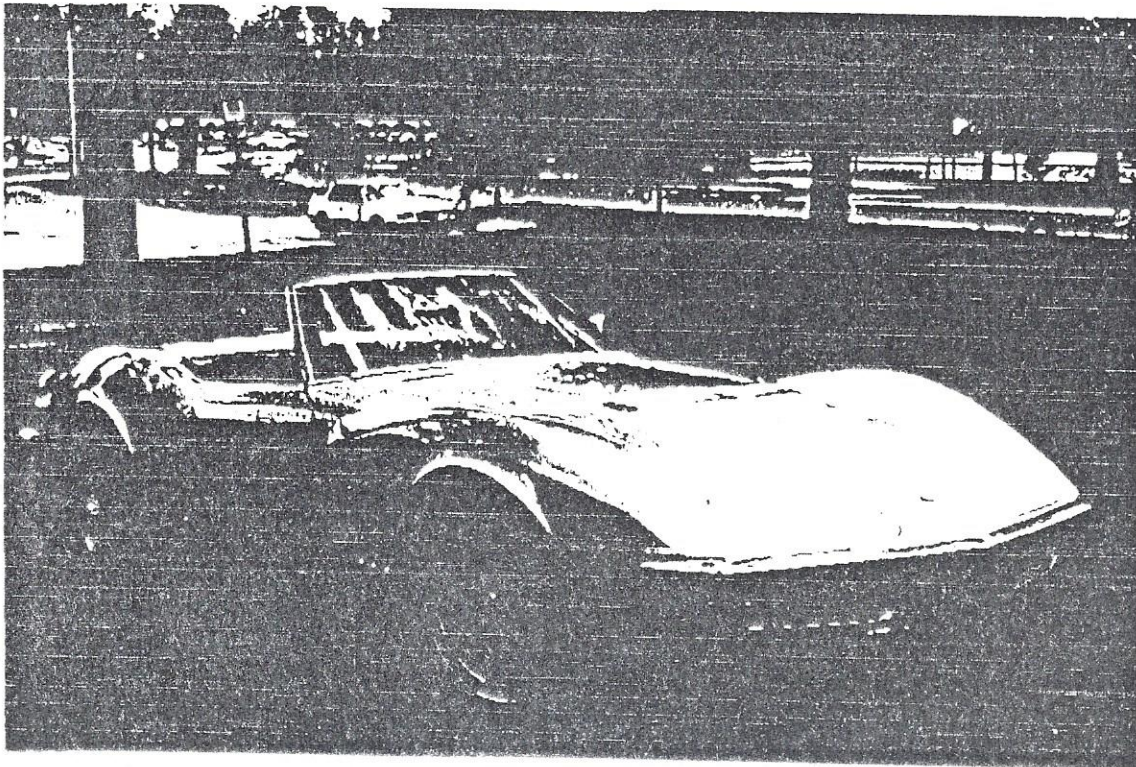
Knoxville, TN. Spring Corvette Expo. March 9-12, 1995. If anyone is interested in going, please call me so we can make reservations.

Beach Trip - Myrtle Beach, SC. September 8-10, 1995. Our annual pilgrimage to the beach will happen again in September.

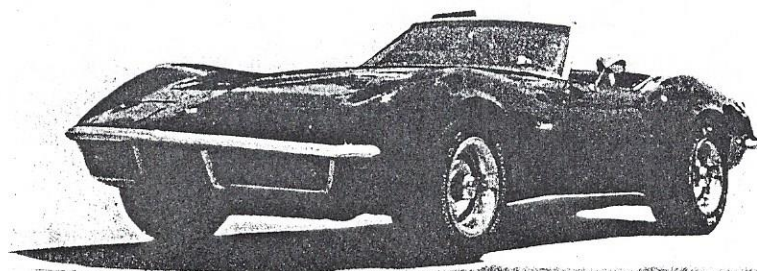
We are also in the early planning stages for various other social events such as a summer pool party, mountain run in the fall and maybe more cruising. If anyone has an idea for a social event, please call me.
