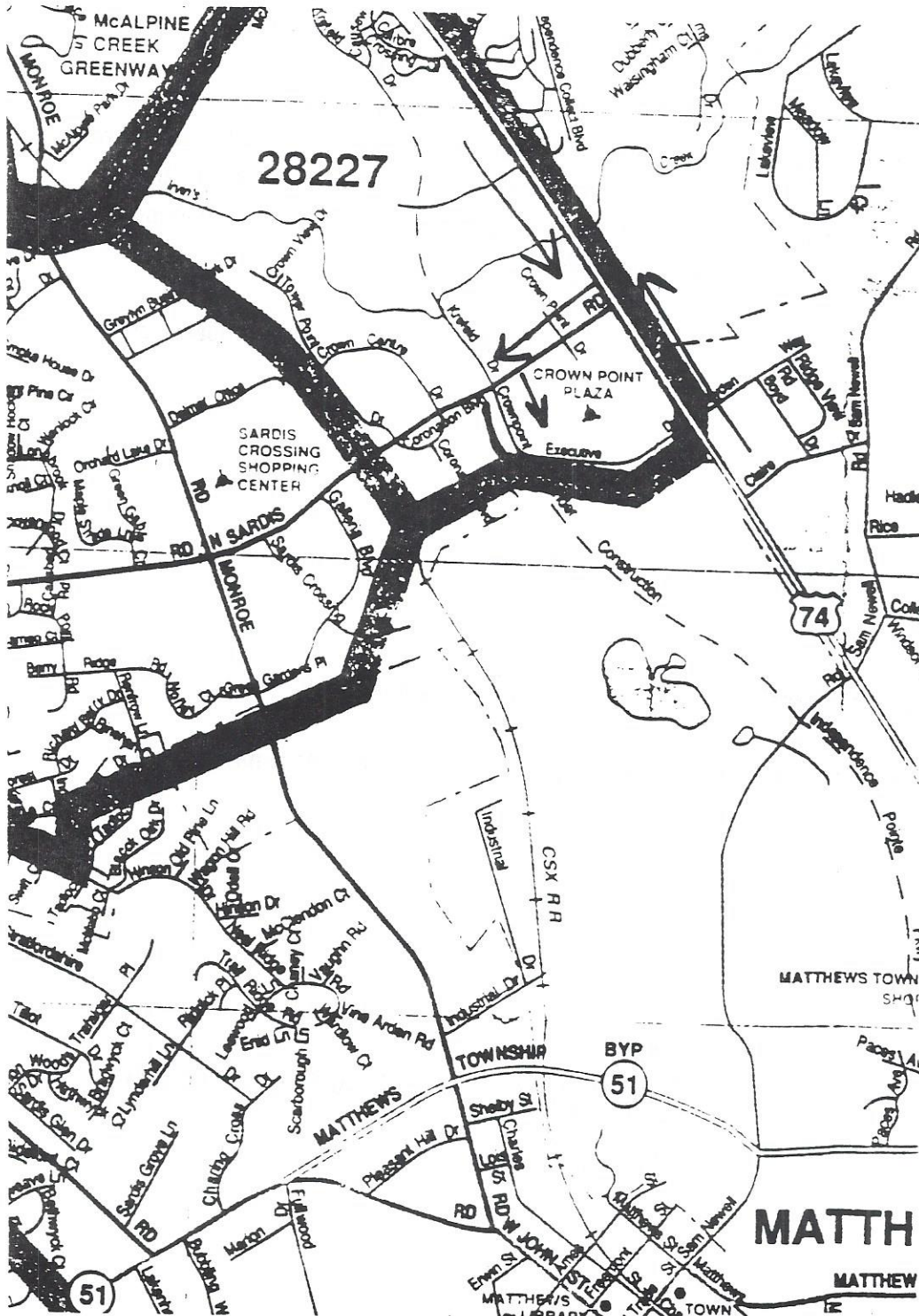


I would like to see more variety of activities for our club this year. More Corvette related events.

- Picnics and sporting events

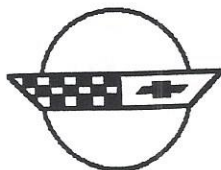
These are suggestions. Please again, your ideas are welcome. Lets have fun with our cars...

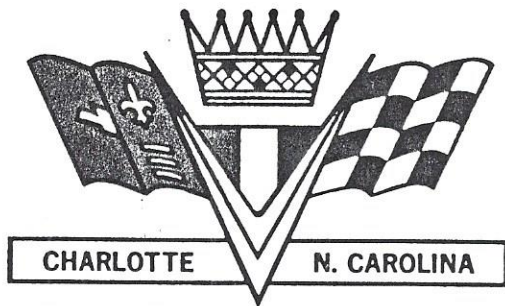
Greg Finnican offered the use of his new building for meetings.

Hope everyone had a HAPPY HOLIDAY AND WE SEE YOU IN 1995!

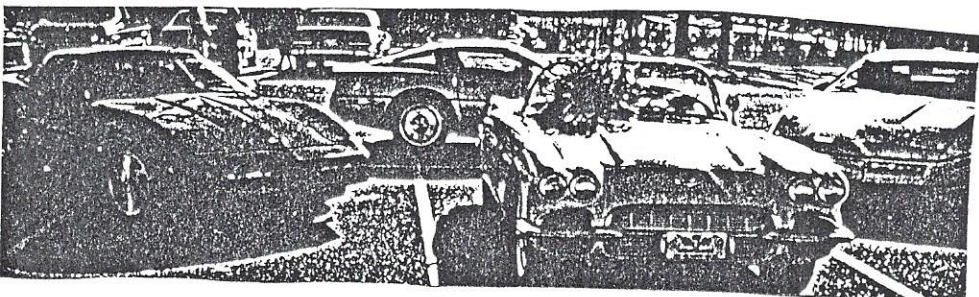


