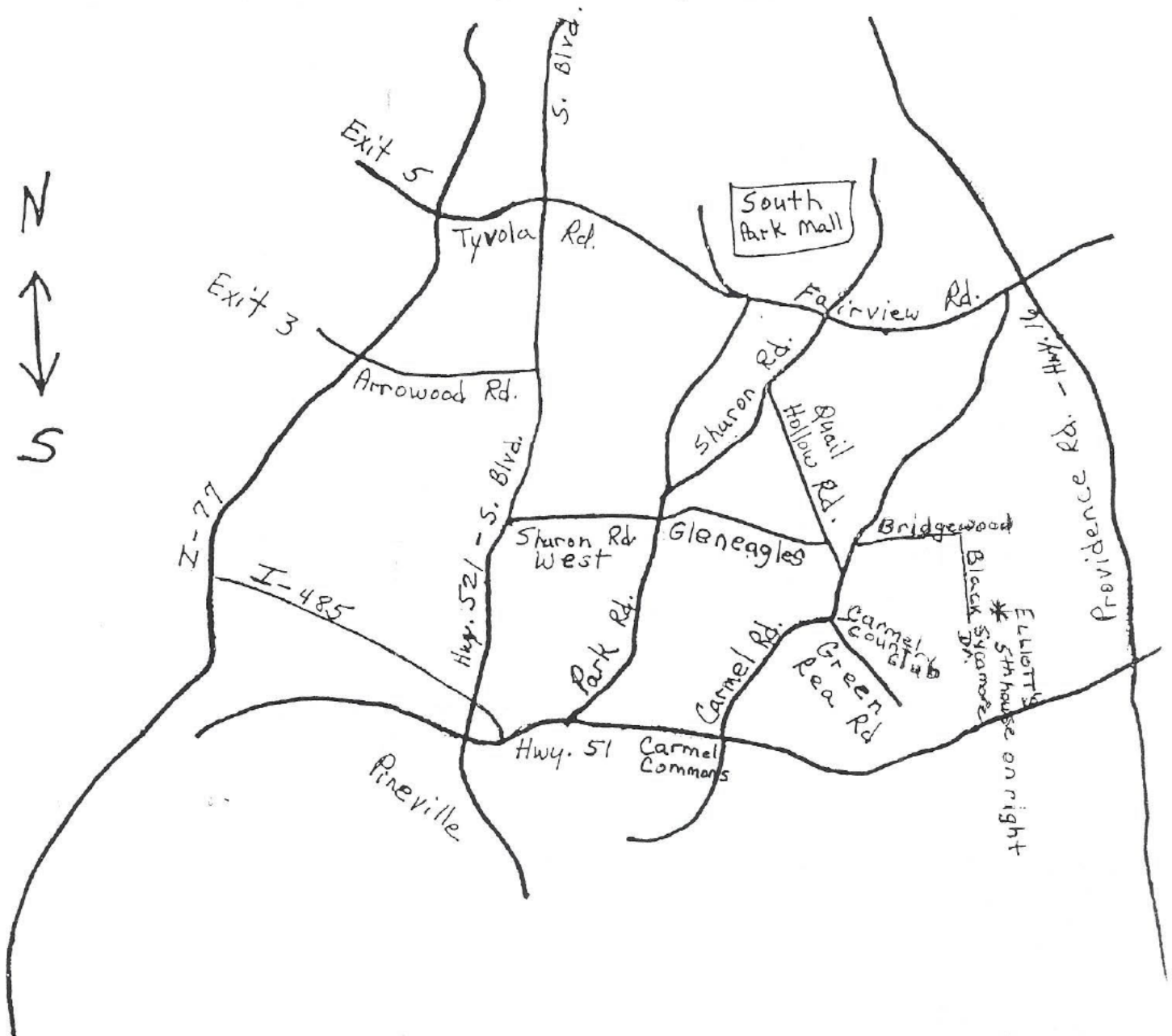

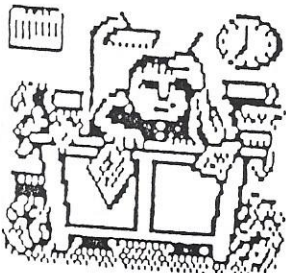
A motion was made that we adjourn the meeting.
