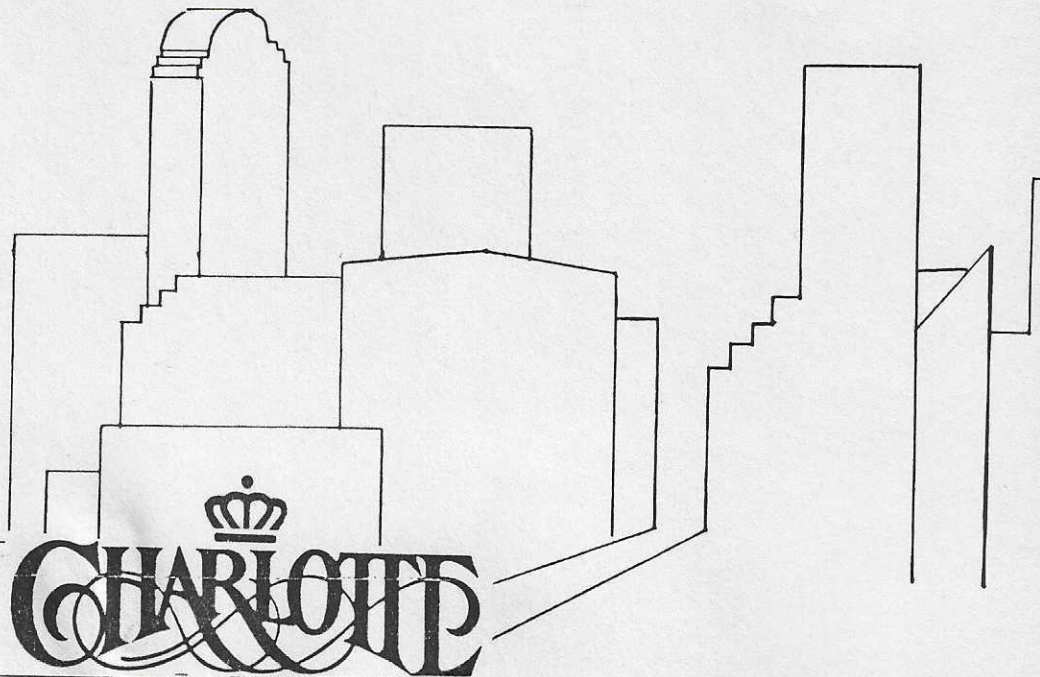

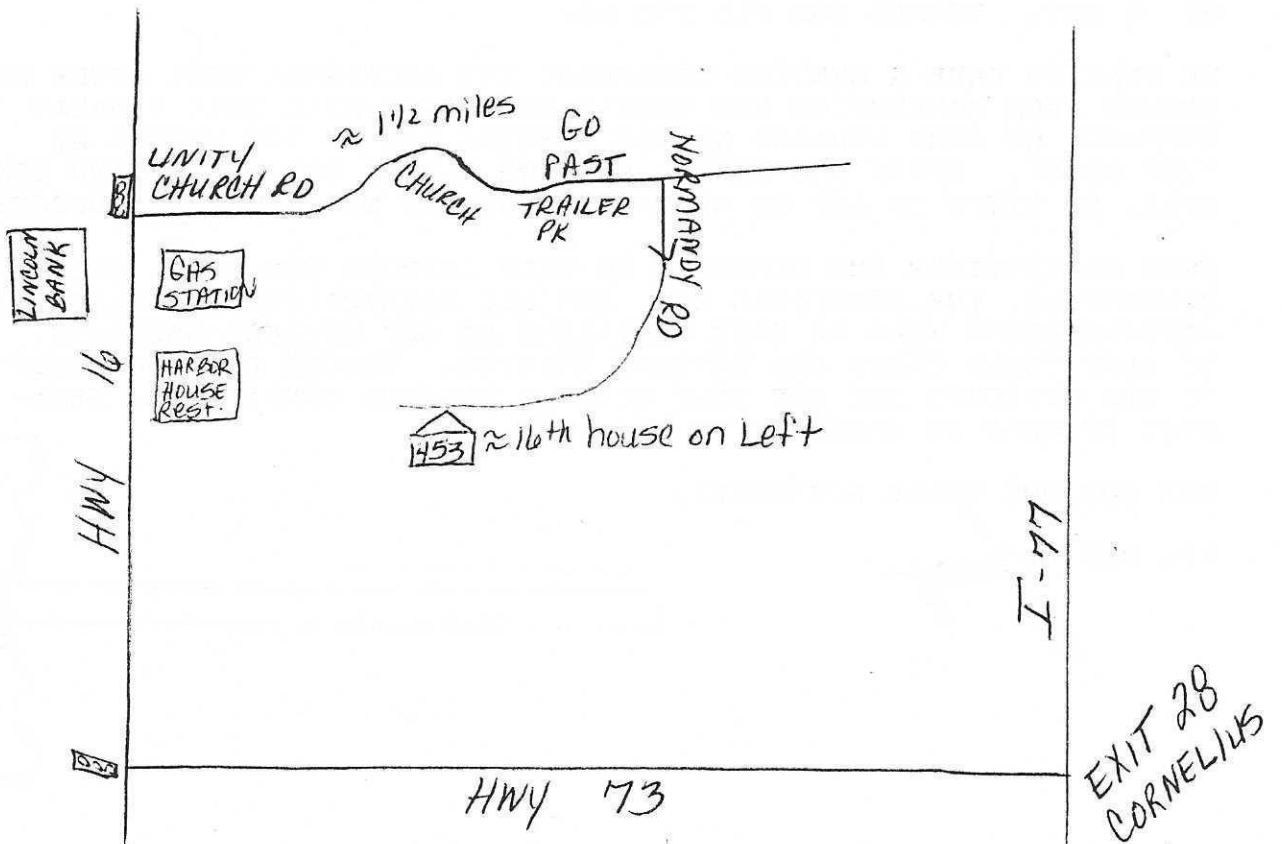

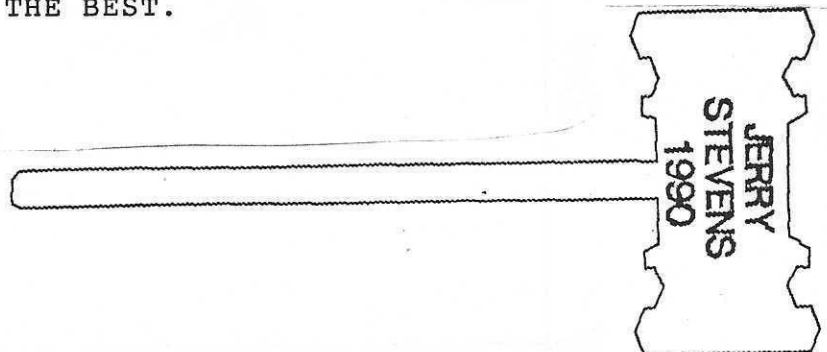

ANNA'S BEAN DIP

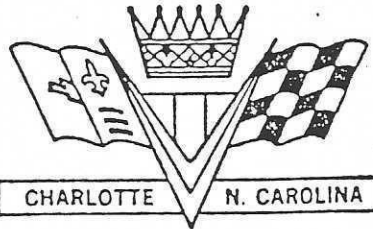
24 Oz of Armour Chili Beans
