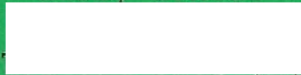

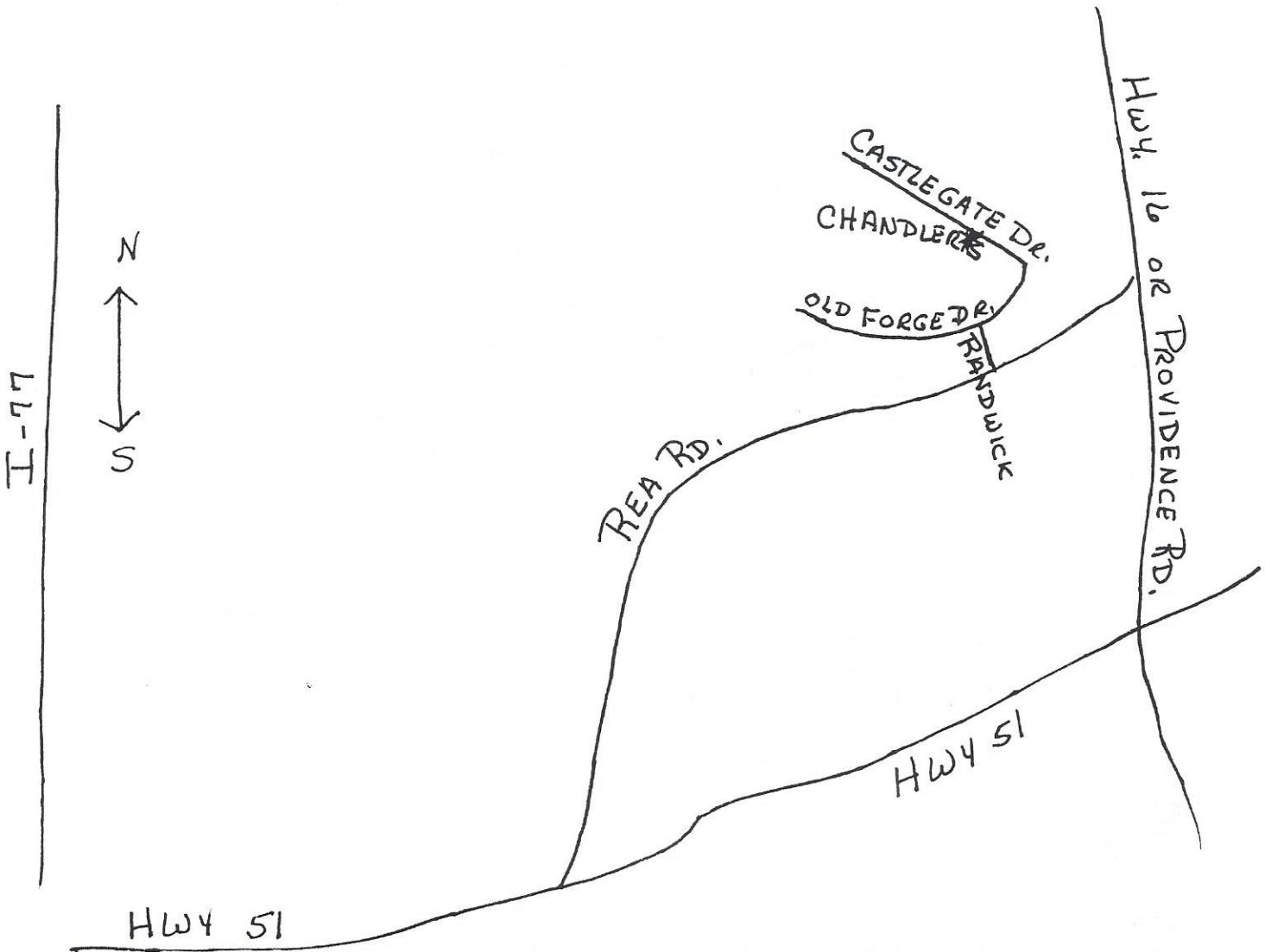

CONGRATULATIONS! TO ALL OF YOU WHO HAD SOMEONE TO GRADUATE:

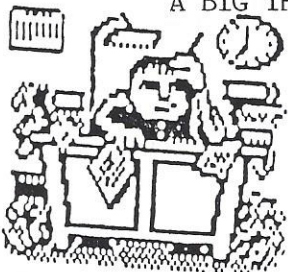

June 10 and 11 are the dates for the 1st regional concours to be held at Marine Chevrolet-Cadillac in Jacksonville, NC, and hosted by Caro-Vettes.

The big news for June is the Corvette Dream and Drive program scheduled for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, June 16-18, at Charlotte Motor Speedway. Many of you don't know what this is and none of us have been involved with one before. This is a program that Chevrolet put together with CMI, a marketing company, about three (3) years ago to enhance Corvette sales. The program works something like this. Chevrolet and CMI set up at a location and bring 10-15 1995 Corvettes along with other support supplies. Then we, under their direction, demonstrate some of the wonderful things the Corvette will do. They have potential buyers signed up to be the receivers of this demo. Each of us who participate are supposed to get a hat, a t-shirt, and lunch for our day's work. This should be a lot of fun since we're driving '95 Corvettes in somewhat of an autocross situation.

We need a minimum of fifteen (15) people each of the three (3) scheduled days. The days run from 7:30 AM until 4-5 PM. We may participate on 1, 2 or all 3 days.
