**HAPPY NEW YEAR!**

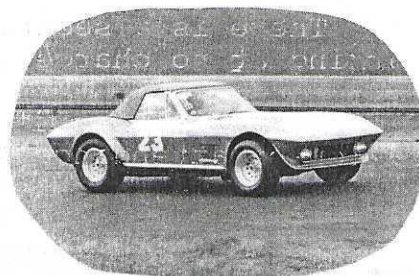

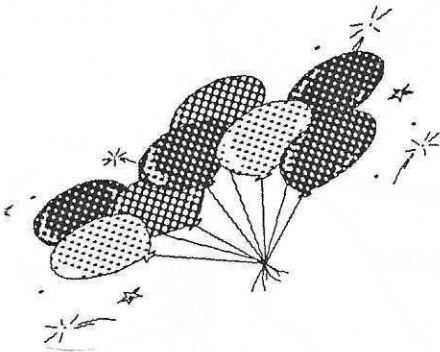

If we all participate, '92 will also be a year we will all remember.

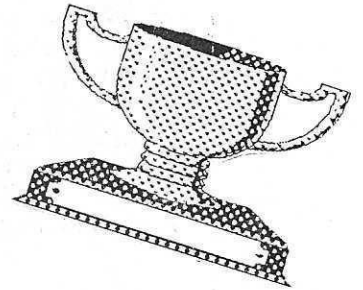

If you want to bring a guest, the charge will be \$17.00 per person.

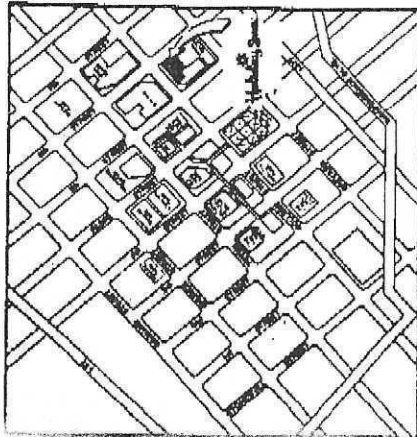

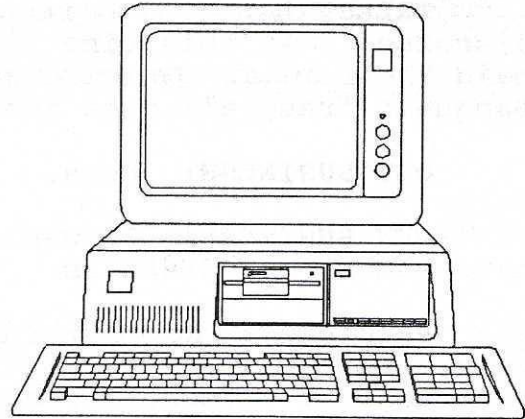
She once again reminded everyone about the upcoming Regional Banquet to be held on February 1, 1992, at the Marriott on Tyvola Road.

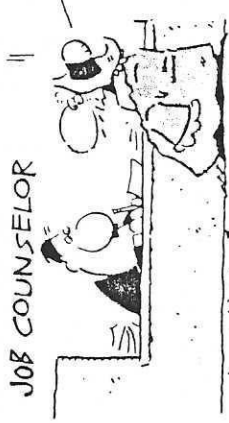
