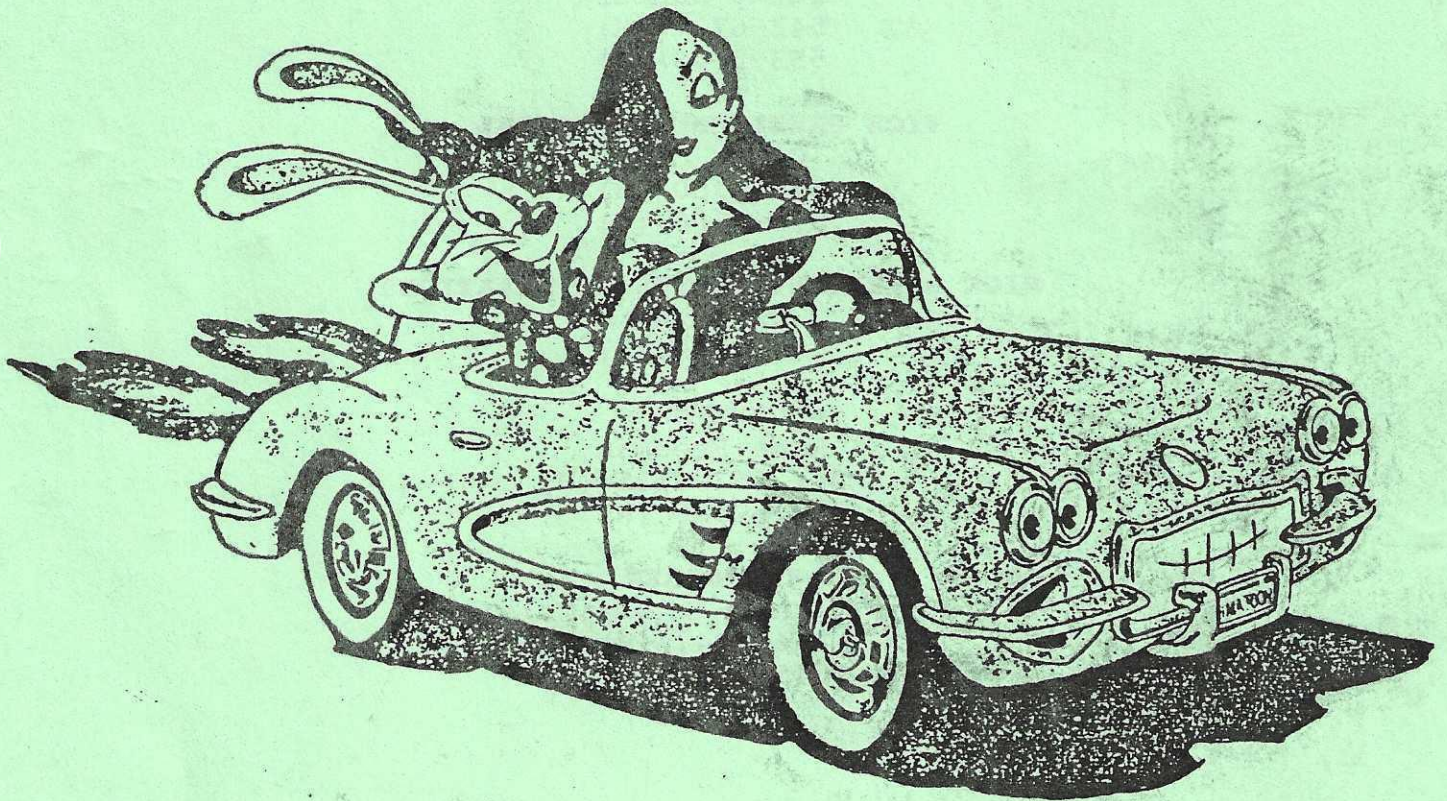

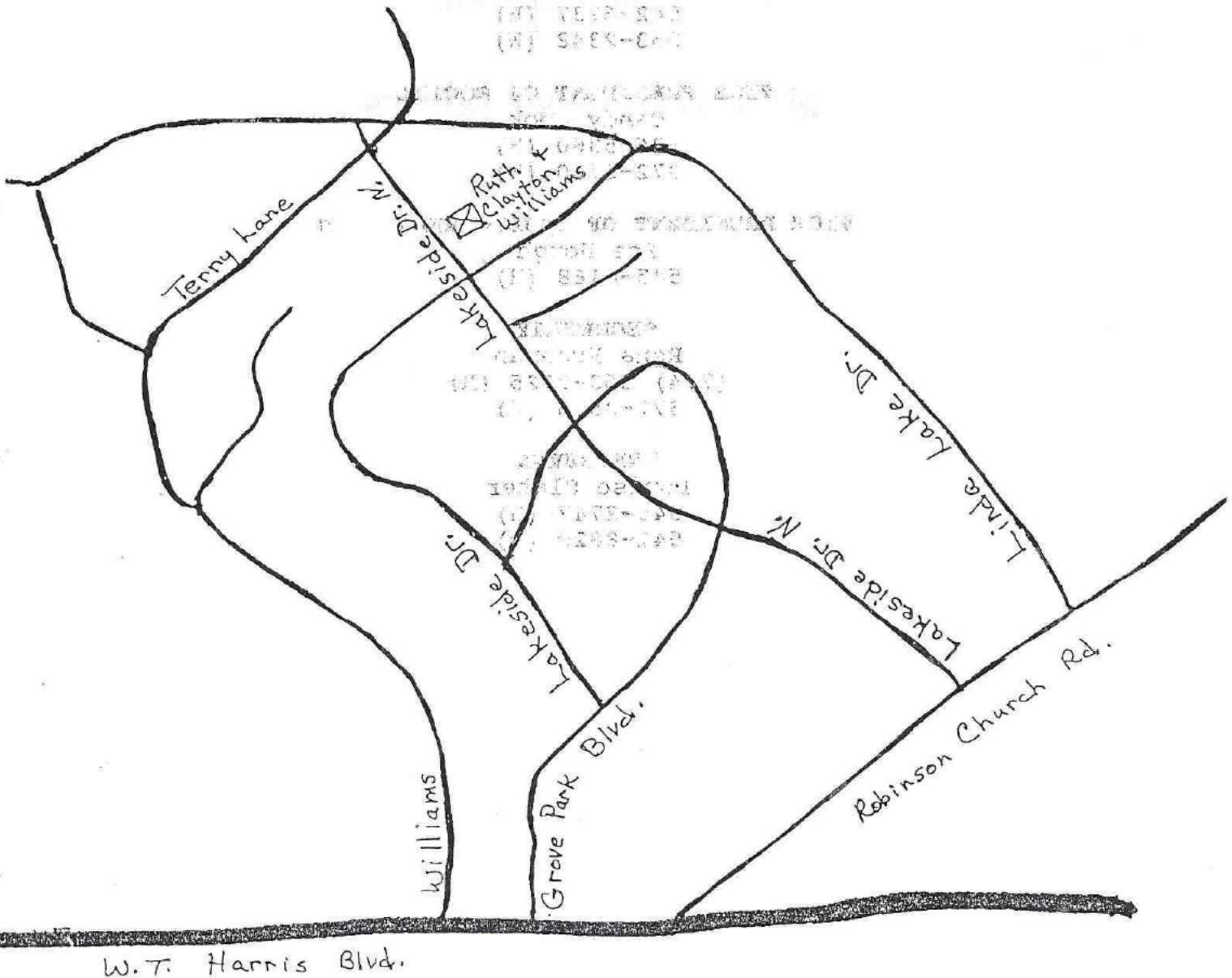

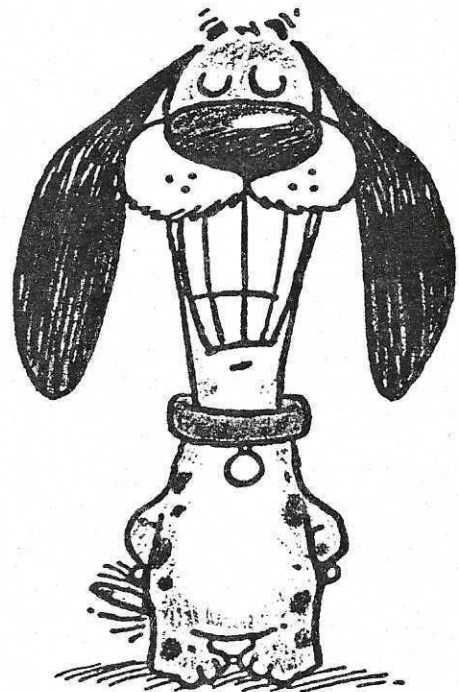


## FROM YOUR CLUB SECRETARY

## V. P. OF COMPETITION'S REPORT

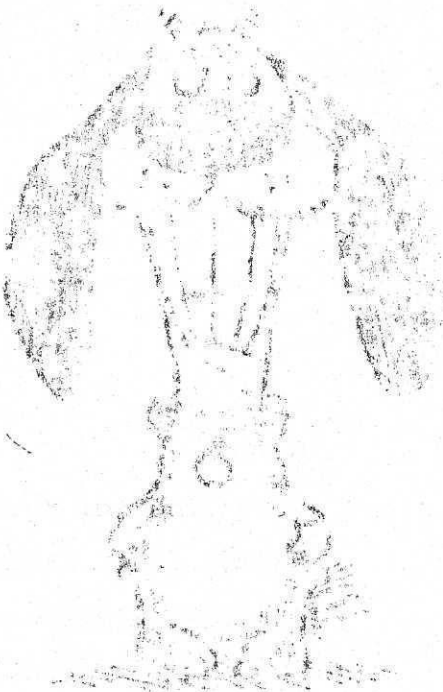
