**JUNE 11, 1993, MINUTES  
QUEEN CITY CORVETTE CLUB MEETING**

**TREASURER:** Don Yost gave the treasurer's report as it appeared in the newsletter. The Spina Bifida tickets have been mailed at this time. If you are holding any tickets, they need to be sent immediately. He also told everyone that we have club t-shirts and license plates for sale.

A resignation letter was read from Vince Sciabica.



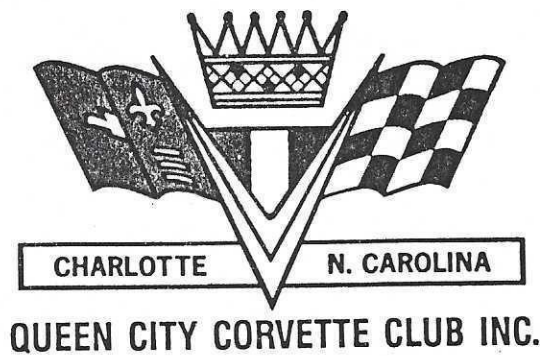

A motion was made and second that the meeting be adjourned.

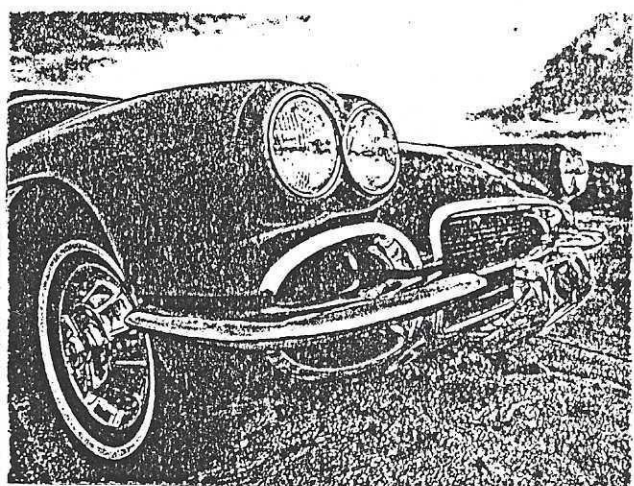
