





4TH OF JULY SOCIAL AFTER COULWOOD PARADE DIRECTIONS TO JAY & RENA FREEMAN'S HOUSE

CHOICE #1. If you travel I-85 South, go passed the truck weigh station and across the Cameron Morrison Bridge. Exit off to the right at the first exit onto Hwy. #273 toward Mt. Holly. As you start to enter Mt. Holly, you will come to an intersection with a McDonald's on the left. This is a new bypass of downtown Mt. Holly, and it takes you to Hwy. #27. (You will go <u>under</u> the railroad and immediately take a left onto Hwy. #27 West.) You are now on your way to Stanley. As you come into Stanley, there will be several stoplights. Proceed on through this little town on up the highway to the "big" town of Alexis. We have a post office and country store on your right at the crossroads of Alexis. There is also a stoplight. TURN RIGHT at the stoplight (Alexis-Lucia Road) and travel approximately one (1) mile to a fork in the road. Take the LEFT fork (Mt. Zion Church Road) and travel approximately one (1) more mile. You are now at a sign on your right that says MT. ZION BAPTIST CHURCH. STOP. TURN LEFT onto the driveway of our house:

CHOICE #2. If you travel Brookshire Freeway, also Hwy. #16
North, stay on this 4-lane highway until it narrows to 2-lanes
(approximately 15 miles). Travel approximately 2 more miles to
LOWESVILLE to a stoplight. TURN LEFT onto The Old Plank Road. You
will see a NATIONSBANK on your right. You will travel on this road
until you see FAITH BAPTIST CHURCH on your left. The first road to
the LEFT after the church will be MT. ZION CHURCH ROAD (approximately 5 miles). TURN LEFT onto this road. You will cross over
two small bridges. After you cross the last bridge, you go up a
hill and around a curve to Jay and Rena's house (approximately 3
miles). When you see the MT. ZION BAPTIST CHURCH sign on your
left, STOP and TURN RIGHT onto our driveway.

If you are attending the Coulwood parade, you can follow us home. This is about a 20 minute drive from the parade site. If you cannot participate in the parade on July 4th, please plan to come on to the social afterwards. We will be back at the house by 1:00 p.m.

Choice #2 is the side of town we will be on for the Coulwood parade.






