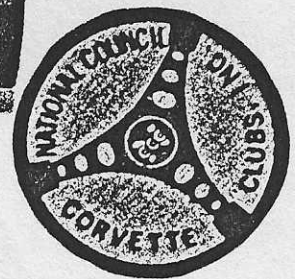

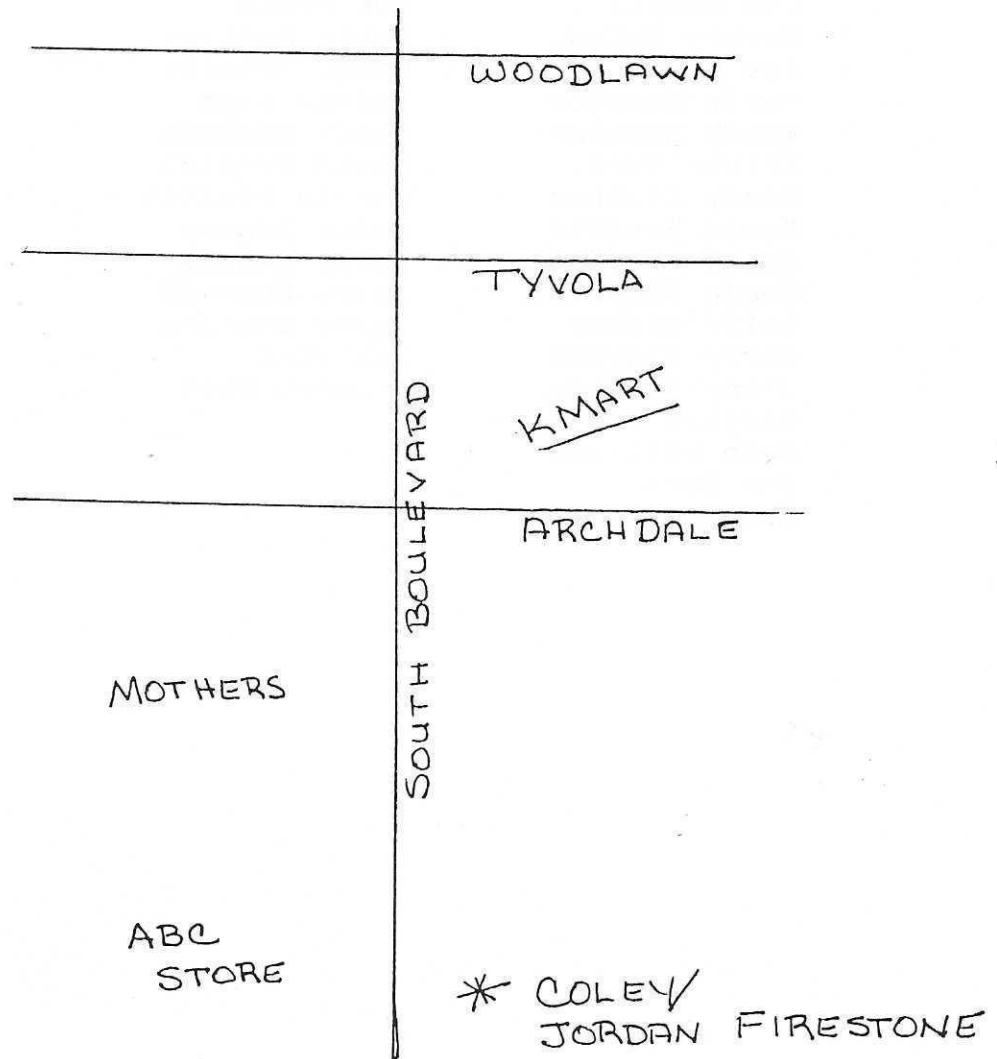

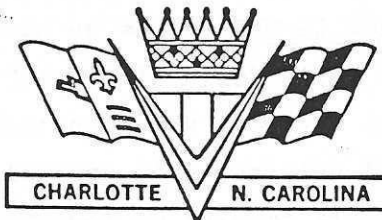

All in all, it was a great job by a great bunch of folks, and I really appreciate the help from each one of you in making things like this work out so successfully.

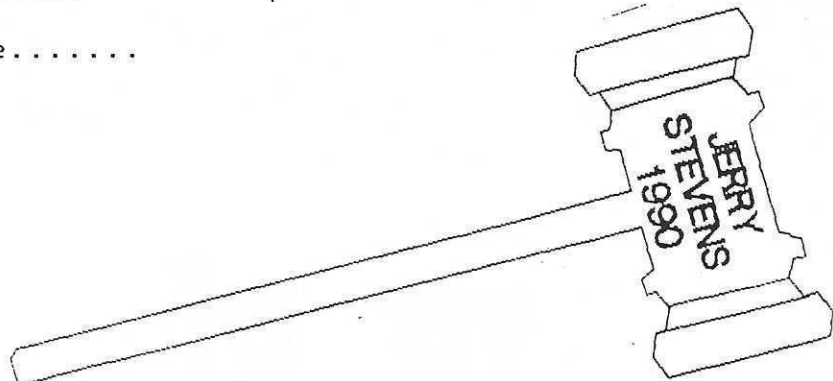

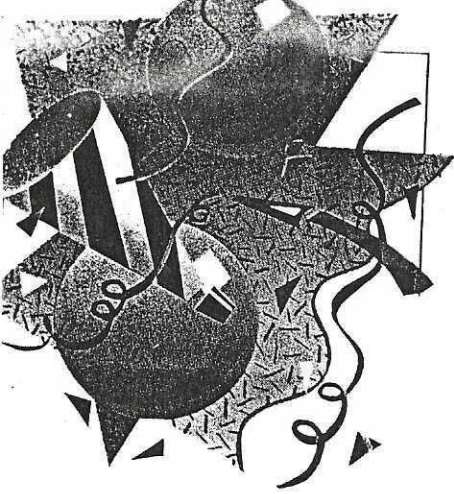
Thanks to John and Jane Freeman for inviting the Club into their home for the February meeting and Valentine Party. Everyone had a real good time, except Mike Tyson.

We have plenty of outdoors activities planned for March.

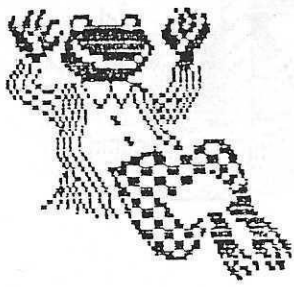

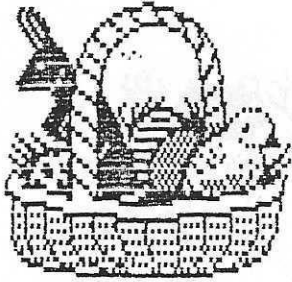
