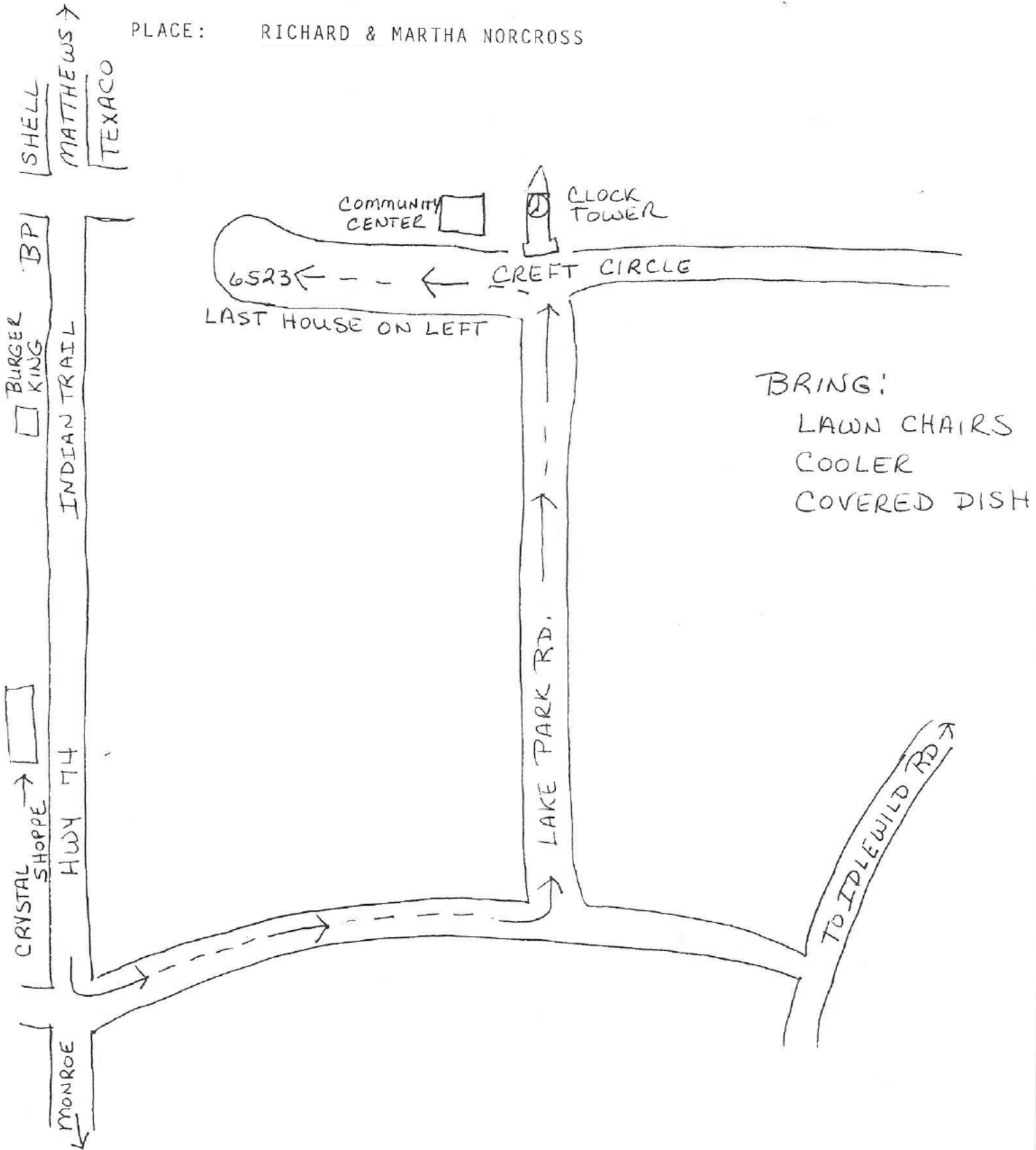




From the President

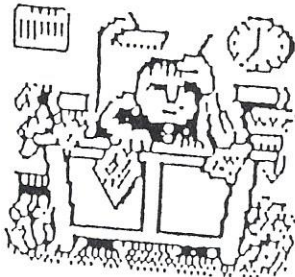
Harry asked everyone to please participate in the selling of Spina Bifida raffle tickets on Saturday and Sunday.

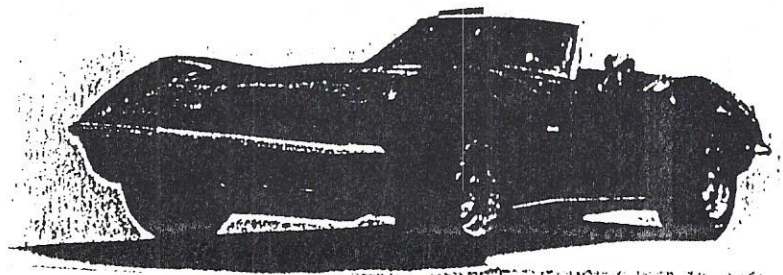

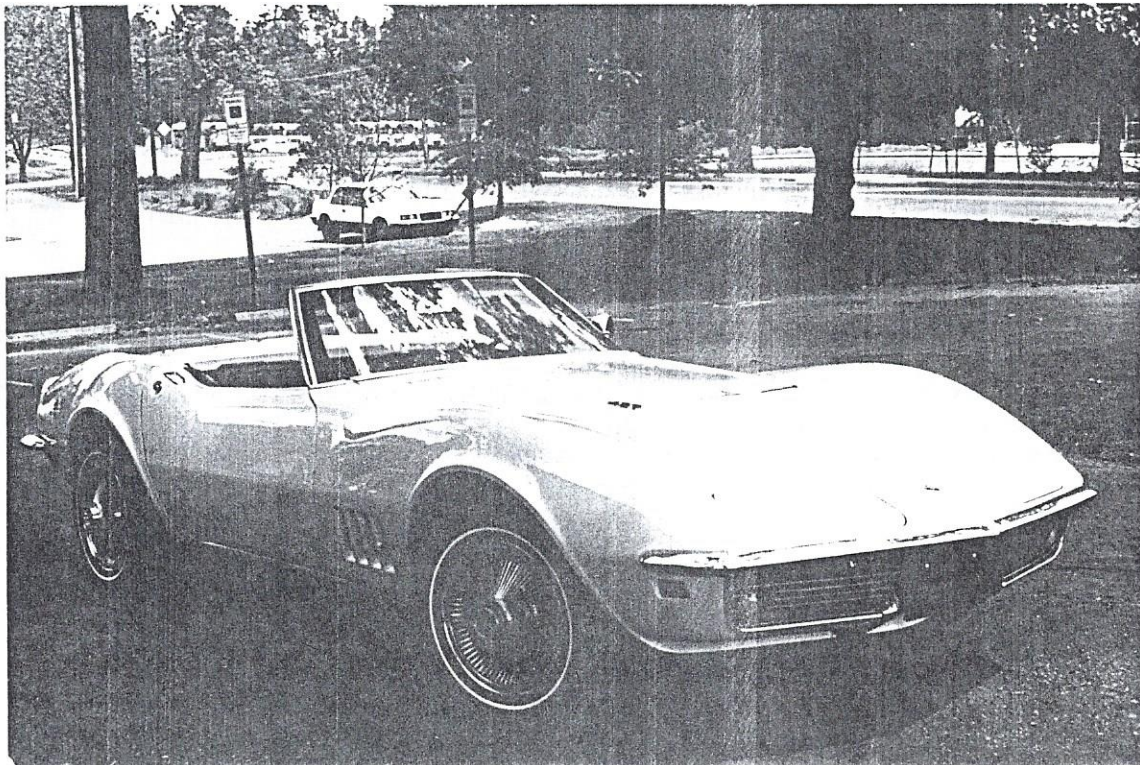

Thanks to everyone who turned out for the Auto Fair. Your help selling raffle tickets was greatly appreciated. We had a great time and the weather was fine.

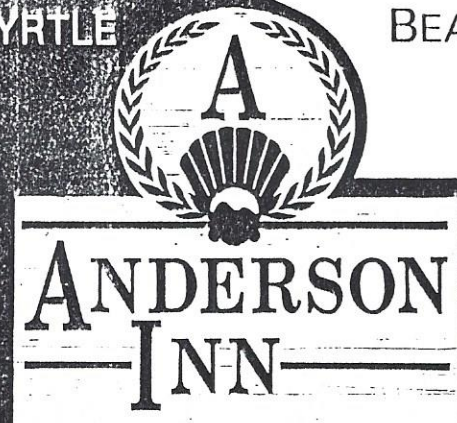
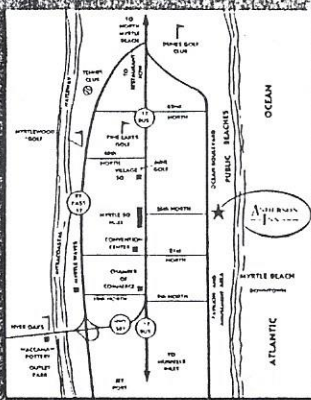
