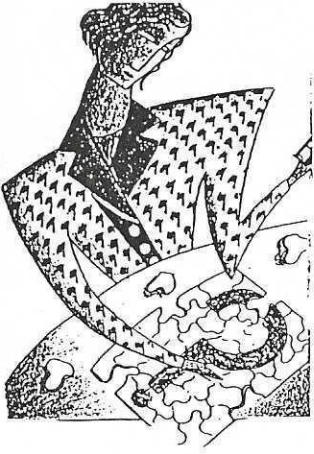
Jerry opened the meeting to discuss old business, The motion from the March Meeting was brought to the floor and passed.
