Well, it's about time for another club meeting, and things are starting to get busy in the club, what with all the activities, convention meetings and the like.

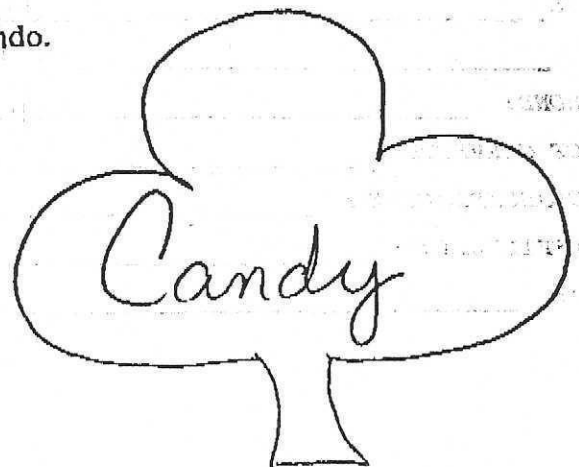
Our next club meeting will be Friday, March 8 at 7:30 at Clayton and Ruth's Corvette condo. I hope to see all my fellow club members there.





Well, it's about time for another club meeting, and things are starting to get busy in the club, what with all the activities, convention meetings and the like.

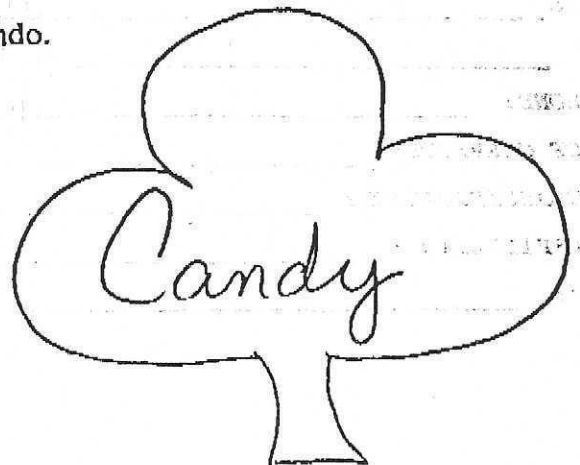
Our next club meeting will be Friday, March 8 at 7:30 at Clayton and Ruth's Corvette condo. I hope to see all my fellow club members there.



FEBRUARY 8, 1991, MINUTES

QUEEN CITY CORVETTE CLUB MEETING

The President called the meeting to order, and the roll was called. There were 23 members present.

The Vice President said that Jackie Profitt had asked him to get some information for her about the t-shirts for convention. Ricky brought several shirts that Jackie wanted us to look at and vote on as to whether we would be interested in the new colors and also vote on whether we should pay fifty cents more per shirt so we could buy only the sizes we wanted and needed and not have to buy smalls and mediums that were not selling.

A motion was made and the club voted "No" to the neon green shirt due to the fact that it would cost approximately \$5 more. It was decided that after we get to the profit side we could possibly consider it again.

Motions were made and the club voted "Yes" to the beige golf shirt and the pink and yellow t-shirts.

A motion was made and the club voted "Yes" to paying fifty cents more per shirt to be able to buy just the sizes we wanted.

The Vice President of Competition reminded us of the Regional Banquet on Saturday night, February 9, in Greenville, SC. She also told us that the next NCCC meeting to be held in Nashville was set for March 1 and 2 and everyone planning to go needed to make their reservations the next day.

He had made arrangements for us to be able to put our cars in on Wednesday evening rather than during the day on Thursday. He also told us they wanted as little gas in the cars as possible and to lock or tape the gas caps closed.

The Vice President of Social had been checking on how late restaurants in the uptown area stayed open so we could all go out to eat on Saturday night after the World of Wheels car show. It was decided that we would all go to Fat Tuesdays. Also, after the club meeting, everyone that could go went to the Rock-Ola Cafe for something to eat.

The Secretary wished all February birthdays a happy birthday and she gave all January and February birthday people a small surprise. She also asked who had read the "hidden" special message in the Newsletter. Don Yost answered and got a special surprise that he very generously shared with everyone.

Clayton Frohn has agreed to be our Trophy Chairman.

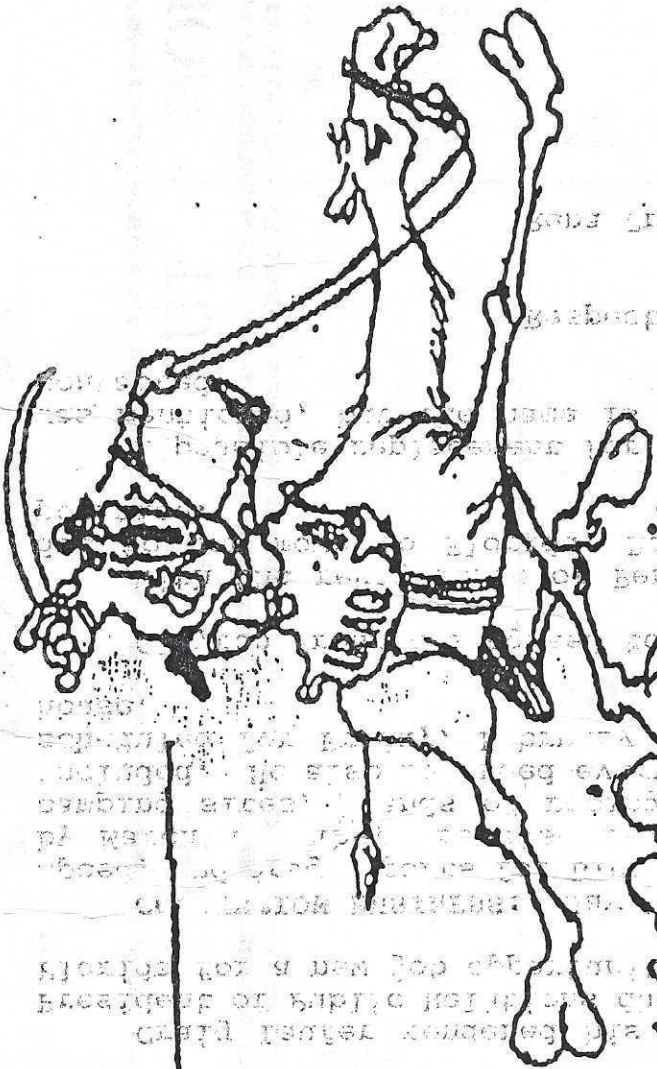
With the resignation of Penny Laufer as Door Prize Chairman due to her move to Florida, Ruth Williams agreed to take this position.

A possible replacement for Craig Laufer as Beverage Chairman was mentioned, but the name is being withheld until he has been contacted.

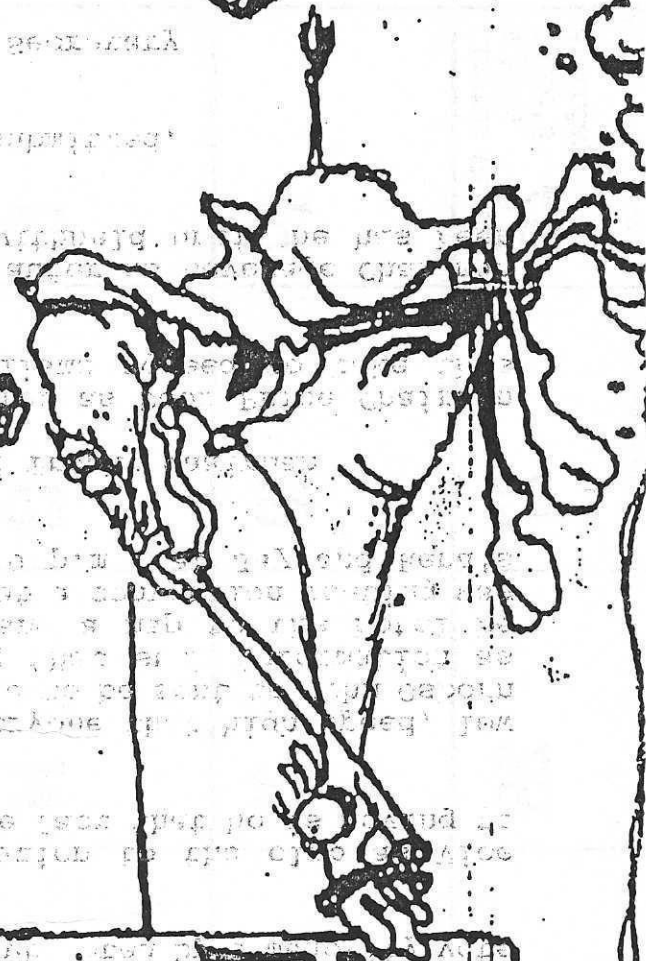
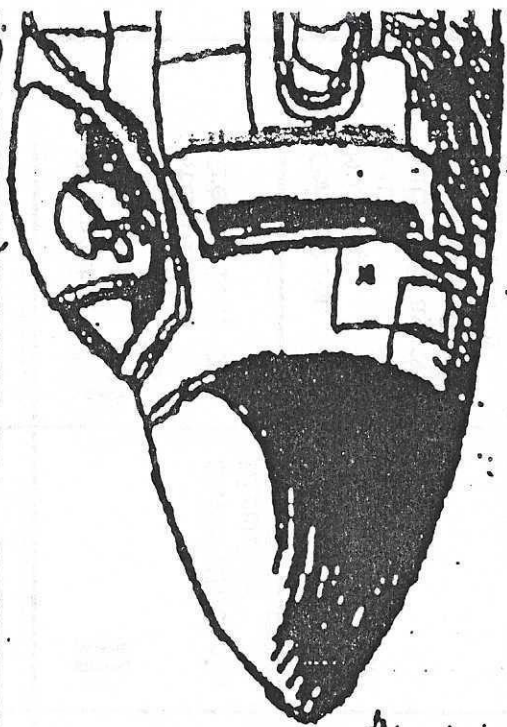
