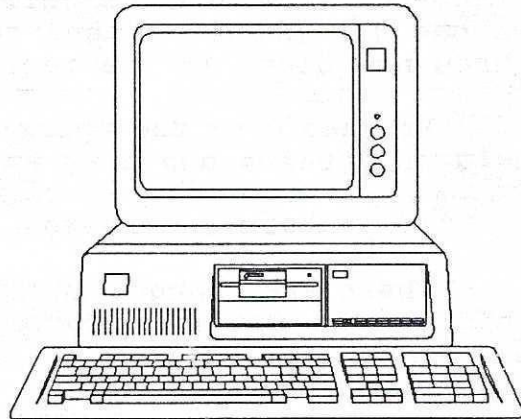
After the St. Patrick's Day Parade on Saturday, March 14th, let's plan to take our cars and get together at the South 21 Drive-In on South Boulevard.

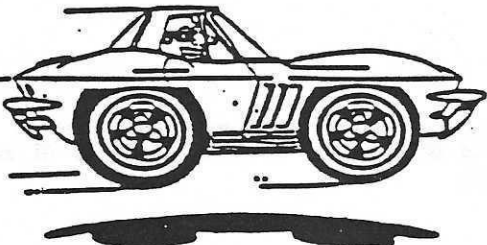
I mention helmets because everyone that competes must have a Snell 85 or better approval. Most of us do not meet this requirement and must purchase new helmets. As I mentioned at the last meeting, Simpson Race Products has offered QCCC members jobber prices on their helmets which are Snell 90 rated. The most economical units are:

LX 5	Open Face - Nylon Interior (Not Recommended)	\$125.
LX 4	Open Face - Nomex Interior (O.K.)	\$147.
LX-Plus	Closed Face -Nomex Interior (Best Buy)	\$179.

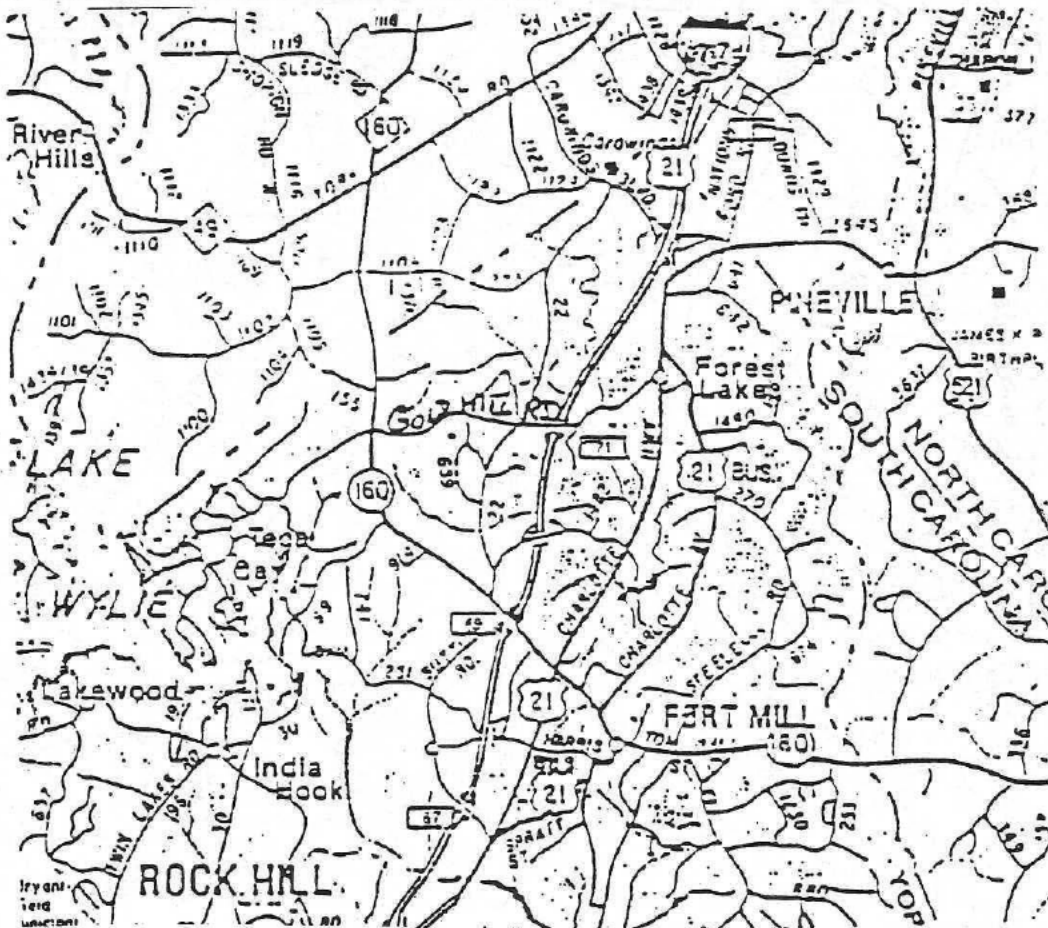

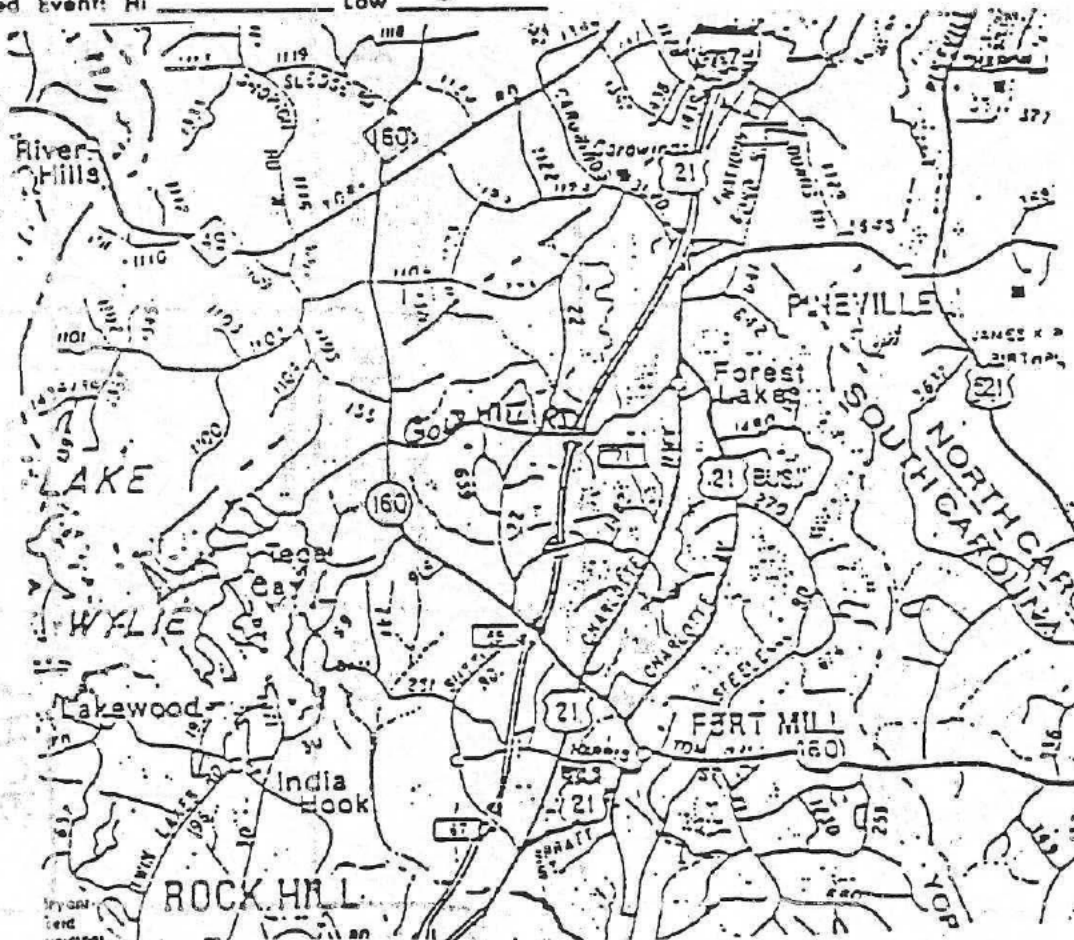
