





Chicken Enchilada Casserole

- 1 whole chicken 4-5 lbs., cooked, deboned, chopped
- 1 bottle Stevie's Italian Dressing (Harris-Teeter sells it.)
- 1 (10-oz.) bag tortilla chips, broken
- 1 small onion, chopped
- 1 (4-oz.) can diced green chilies
- 1 to 2 Tablespoons diced jalapeno peppers (I used more than this)
- 1 can cream of celery soup
- 1 can tomatoes, chopped
- 1-1/2 cups shredded cheddar cheese

Dash of chili powder (I sprinkled it all over top)

- * Boil chicken, debone, and chop into bite-size pieces. Pour about 3/4 bottle of the Stevie's Dressing over chicken and let it marinate about 30 minutes. Layer chips in bottom of 13x9-inch baking dish. Layer chicken on top of chips.
- * Combine all other ingredients except cheddar cheese and chili powder. Pour mixture over chicken. Top with cheese and sprinkle with chili powder.
- * Bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes or until bubbly.
