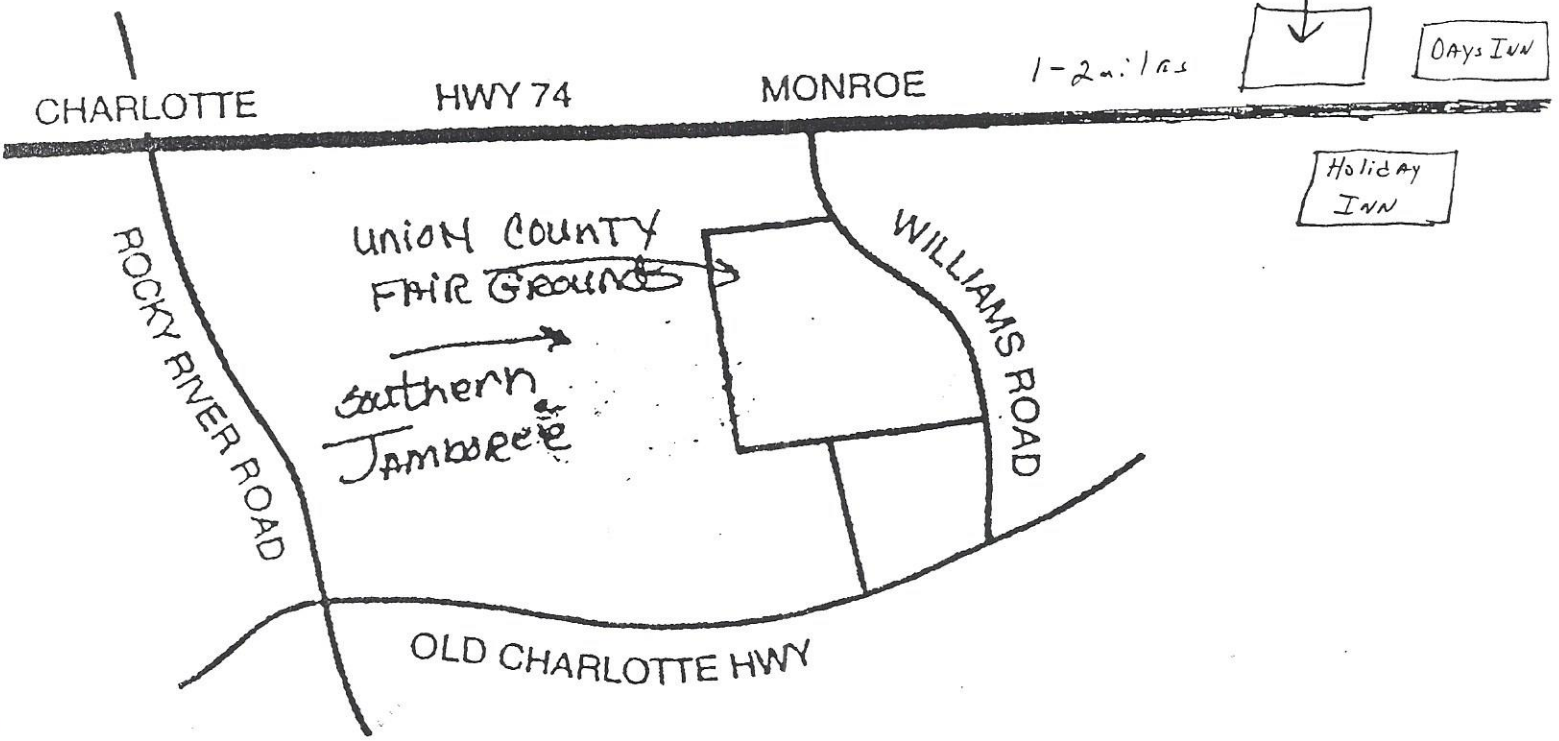

## VICE PRESIDENT OF SOCIAL

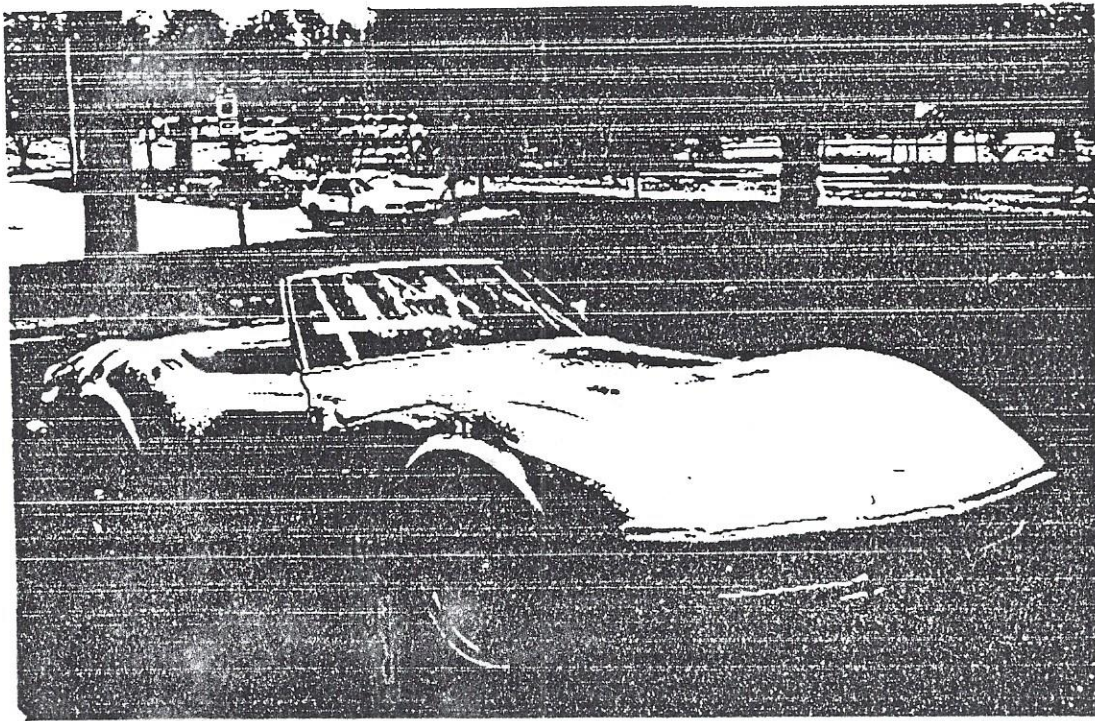
