The recent homecomings have been big hits, and believe it or not, Greg Currie does exist! He joined us for the South Meck homecoming. It was good to see you Greg.

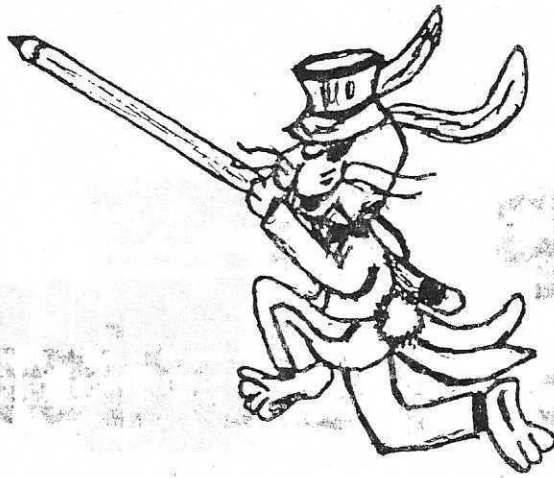

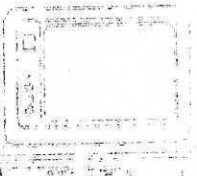
Thanks to Maureen Yost for chairing the Providence High School homecoming parade. Also, thanks to all the club members for their participation.
