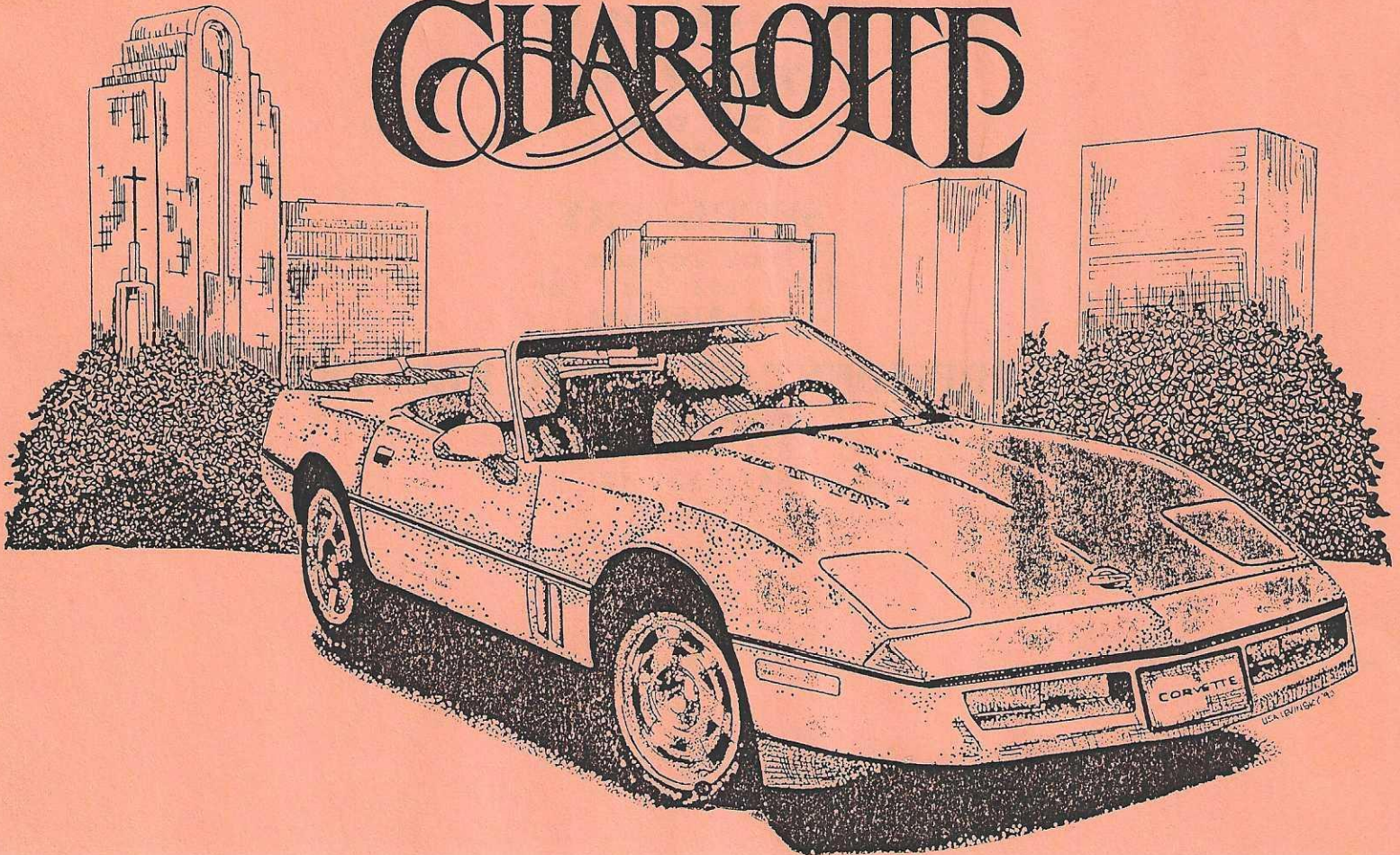

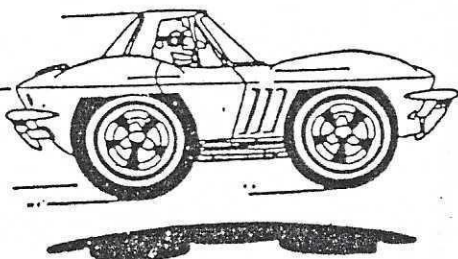

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

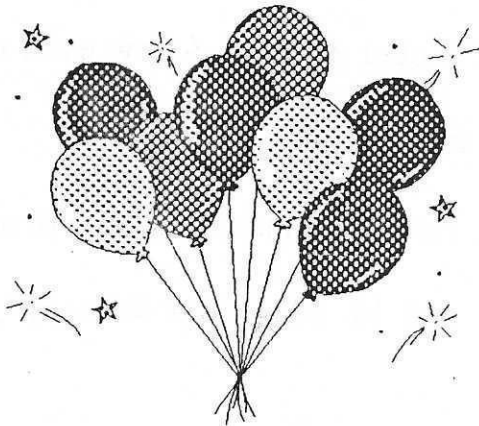
Thanks to everyone for attending the October events. A few even made it to South Mecklenburg High Homecoming in the rain.

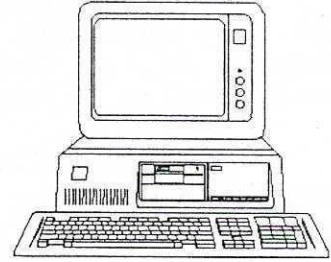

Theresa Tilton told the club that there is a conference room available where she works for the monthly club meetings if the club would like to use it.

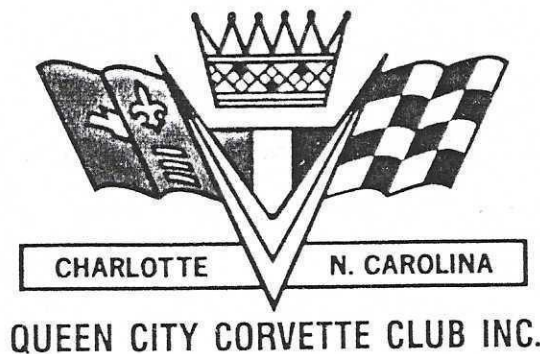
Mike Catoe reminded everybody to vote on Joe Dudick for a new club member as soon as the meeting was adjourned.
