SUBJECT: 1991 NCCC CONVENTION

AS MOST OF YOU ARE AWARE, QUEEN CITY CORVETTE CLUB IS HOSTING THE 1991 NCCC CONVENTION IN CHARLOTTE JULY 13 THRU JULY 20, 1991.

WE ARE PLANNING WHAT WE THINK WILL BE A GREAT TIME FOR ALL WHO ATTEND AND REALLY HOPE THAT MOST CAROLINA REGION PEOPLE WILL TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS OPPORTUNITY TO GO TO AN NCCC CONVENTION SO CLOSE TO HOME.

BECAUSE WE ARE THE ORGANIZATION THAT "VOLUNTEERED" TO HOST THE CONVENTION, WE ARE DOING AS MUCH OF THE PRE-PLANNING AND ADVANCE WORK AS POSSIBLE WITHOUT BURDENING YOU OR YOUR CLUB MEMBERS. MANY, MANY HOURS OF PLANNING, ORGANIZING, AND SCHEDULING HAVE ALREADY BEEN EXPENDED BY MEMBERS OF QUEEN CITY WITH MANY MORE TO FOLLOW. AS I MENTIONED AT YOUR GOVERNOR'S MEETING EARLY THIS YEAR IN SPARTANBURG (PRIOR TO REGIONAL BANQUET), WE WILL NEED SOME HELP FROM OTHER NCCC MEMBERS JUST LIKE PREVIOUS HOSTS. WE ARE NOT SURE EXACTLY HOW MANY PEOPLE OR MAN HOURS WE NEED YET, BUT WE DO KNOW THAT OUR BUSIEST DAYS WILL BE MONDAY, TUESDAY, AND WEDNESDAY, JULY 15 THRU JULY 17. SEVERAL OF YOU AND OR YOUR CLUB MEMBERS HAVE AGREED/VOLUNTEERED TO HELP AND WE DO APPRECIATE THAT ATTITUDE AND SUPPORT.

WE ASKED THE STEERING COMMITTEE AND RECEIVED APPROVAL TO GIVE A DAY PASS TO NCCC MEMBERS WHO WORK/HELP DURING THE EVENTS OF A PARTICULAR DAY. DAY PASSES ARE FOR PEOPLE WHO DO NOT REGISTER FOR THE ENTIRE CONVENTION BUT WHO WANT TO ATTEND AN EVENT OR A PARTY ETC. DAY PASSES NORMALLY COST BETWEEN \$20 AND \$35 PER DAY. DAY PASSES DO NOT ALLOW YOU TO ENTER/RUN IN ANY COMPETITION EVENT BUT IS A WAY FOR THOSE WHO CAN'T BE THERE ALL WEEK AND WHO DON'T ENTER EVENTS TO GET A GOOD FLAVOR OF WHAT CONVENTION FUN AND FELLOW-SHIP IS ALL ABOUT.

I HAVE ATTACHED A LIST OF CHAIRMEN AND A PRELEMINARY SCHEDULE OF THE WEEKS ACTIVITIES. IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN HELPING AND/OR NEED A DAY PASS OR IF YOU WILL BE AT CONVENTION ANYWAY AND WOULD LIKE TO HELP, PLEASE LET ME OR A CHAIRMAN KNOW WHAT YOU WILL DO AND WHEN YOU ARE AVAILABLE.

WE PUT THE CAROLINA REGION PATCH ON THE FRONT OF THE 1991 CONVENTION TEE SHIRT BECAUSE WE WANT ALL CLUBS IN THE REGION TO FEEL A PART OF THIS CONVENTION BUT WE HAVE NO INTENTION OF DUMPING THE RESPONSIBILITY OF IT ON ANYBODY BUT US. WE DO APPRECIATE YOUR HELP AND SUPPORT IN MAKING THIS ONE OF THE BEST CONVENTIONS EVER HELD.
