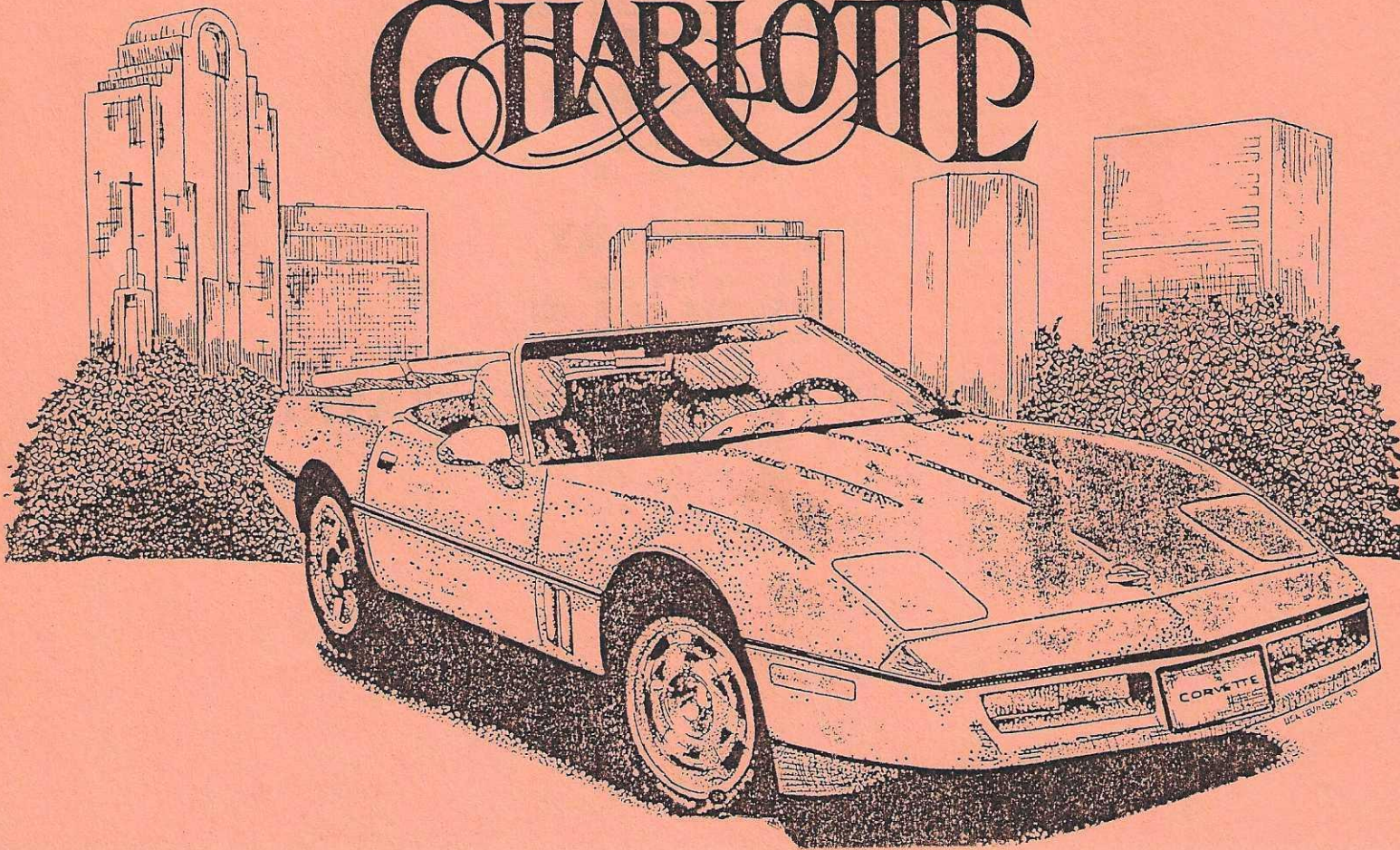

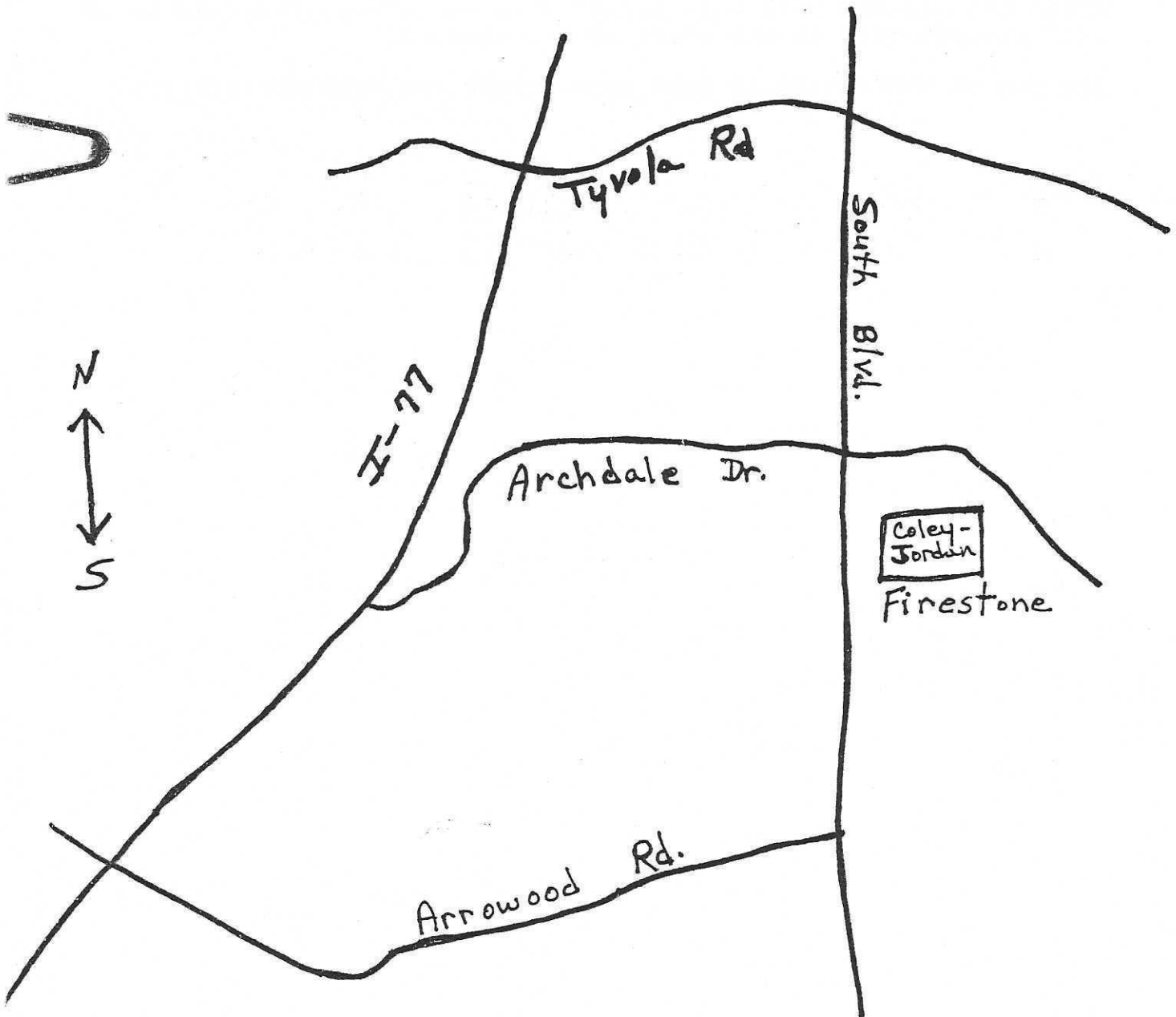

VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT

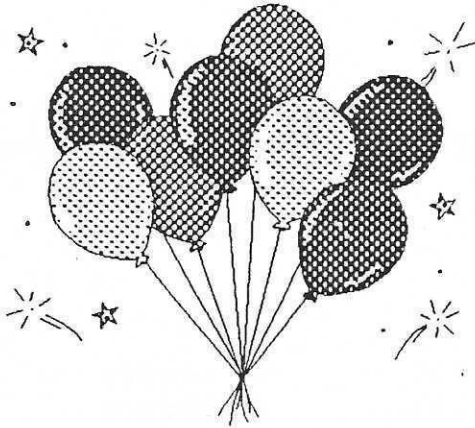
