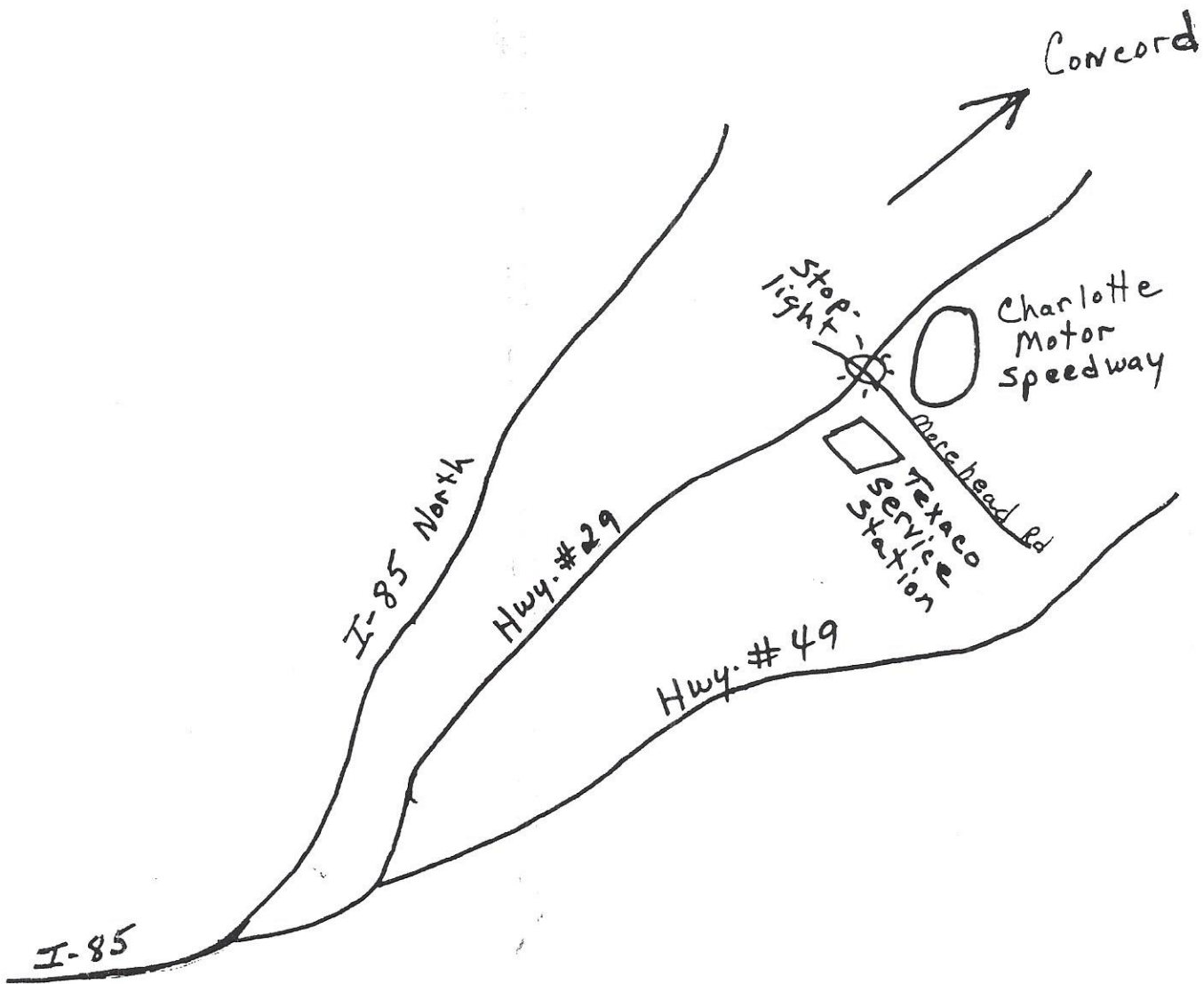

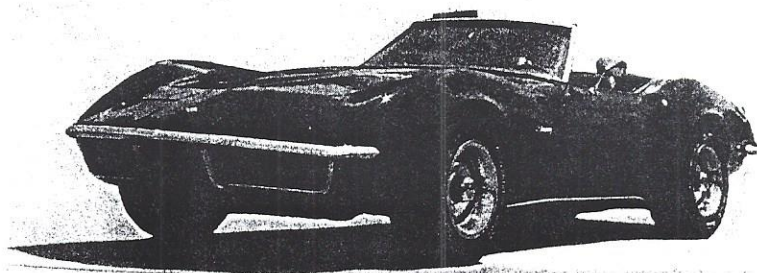


FROM THE V.P.

Larry went over the treasurer's report as published in the newsletter. We have ordered some QCCC white caps. Your 3rd quarter dues are due.

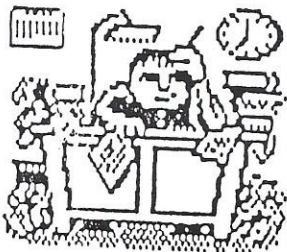
